10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

Girl Scouts Nations Capital is among the largest and most diverse Girl Scout councils in the country, with 76,648 members, including 16,778 Girl Scouts in grades K-12 and 10,385 adult volunteers in the state of Maryland. Our Council spans Washington, D.C., and 25 surrounding counties in Maryland, Virginia, and West Virginia. Our mission is to give girls and gender-expansive youth opportunities to build the courage, confidence, and character they need to make the world a better place. We achieve this through out-of-school, volunteer-led programming that focuses on the outdoors, entrepreneurship, life skills, and STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math).

## **11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit length to visible area)

Camp Aquasco is a beautiful property spanning 172 acres that has served Girl Scouts since 1974. One side of the camp is owned by Girl Scouts Nations Capital, with 86 acres and a large lodge and a camping unit; the other is for camping only and consists of 88 acres leased from the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission. In 2023, the camp served 1,570 campers and 730 adults. It provides essential outdoor programing that encourages healthy living, boosts mental wellness, and offers opportunities to make lasting friendships. Grant funds awarded in the 446th Session have already made an impact. Enhanced support will make a critical difference in further improving the quality and longevity of camp infrastructure. Planned improvements include building new glen shelters, an expanded parking lot, improved lodge decking for safety, HVAC installation, conversion to an electric stove, the installation of new beds and shelter siding, and long-lifespan equipment.
