## 10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

The mission of Heartly House is to end domestic violence, sexual assault, human trafficking and child abuse, and to provide victims with safety, shelter, and supportive services. For 45 years, Heartly House has been the only provider in Frederick County, of comprehensive services including 24/7 crisis hotline, crisis intervention, lethality assessment program coordination, medical accompaniment, emergency shelter, case management, individual and group counseling, legal representation, and advocacy. In addition, our work to end powerbased violence includes community education, outreach and prevention programs and trainings as well as English and Spanish speaking abuse intervention programs.

## **11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit length to visible area)

The Heartly House Renovation Project aims to significantly expand the organizations ability to serve survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, and human trafficking. The proposed renovations will transform the existing two-story facility currently a mix of office space and client living quarters into a fully residential space. This redesign is expected to nearly triple capacity, allowing more individuals to access safe shelter and support services. The project also includes the creation of multiple ADA-accessible suites, ensuring that all clients, regardless of mobility needs, have access to safe and supportive housing.
