Howard County Chinese School (HCCS), located in Howard County, MD, is a non-profit, non-political, and non-religious school established in 1998. Its missions are to promote Chinese culture and language through high-quality educational and cultural classes, to advance the Chinese-American culture/art by providing diverse programming, lifelong learning and cultural/art participation, and to promote community well-being, civic engagement, as well as collaboration with other racial/ethnic communities in Howard County and beyond. HCCS is the home of more than 1.2 thousand students and their families, with the present majority are from local Howard County and neighboring counties. Over the past two decades, HCCS has successfully delivered Pre-K to 10th grade Chinese language courses, bilingual both young students and adult learners.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

For over 26 years, Howard County Chinese School (HCCS) has been committed to promoting community diversity and strengthening Asian American identity through a wide range of language and cultural heritage programs. In recently years, a major challenge limiting HCCS growth is the lack of adequate facility space, particularly for its cultural programs. The requested funding, along with matching contributions, will be used to acquire additional facilities and spaces for educational and cultural activities. This expansion is crucial to meet the increasing demand within the Asian American, particularly Chinese American community for enhanced space and improved facilities, and this expansion is also critical to facilitate the cultural engagement among all communities.
