Founded in July of 2022, by Randy K. Rowel Jr, Breaking Boundaries Environmental (BBE) aims to foster a sustainable future for our Maryland communities by championing environmental stewardship and natural resource management. This historic descendant community of Browns Woods served as a safe space for Black residents to access nature, water, and recreation in a safe space. The location remains and is currently for sale. Considering the states in budget-cut mode, there is a willingness to reduce the amount of the least important budget areas.
