GBMG owns and operates Liberty Sports Park. GBMG is organized exclusively for educational and charitable purposes, and is committed to the education and development of sports programs and competitions for youth and adult					

individuals, families, and communities. Its activities include, but are not limited to, promoting sports education generally, promoting amateur sports competitions and sports performances for the public, promoting sports education, including developing and promoting sports education programs and competitions for elementary, middle and high school students.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The purpose of this project is to enhance Liberty Sports Park (LSP) by adding landscaping components, a memorial flag court and add additional parking. In regards to parking, LSP currently has 550 parking spaces. With the majority of the weekend events that are hosted at LSP, there is a need for over 1,000 parking spaces. Currently, neighboring business parking lots are utilized but it is felt that relying on another business's parking spaces will not be sustainable. Adding additional parking on LSP's property will help maintain and secure the hosting of more large events each year. Larger events bring higher tax revenues into the State and County due to the amount of out of town visitors that come to LSP.
