The Maryland Center for the Arts is a non-profit organization with the mission to build and operate a visual and performing arts campus that will provide a broad range of creative and collaborative experiences in terms of quality education, presentations, and exhibits in all disciplines of the arts. The vision of the Maryland Center for the Visual and Performing Arts is to be a premiere arts and entertainment venue, and an organization that ensures everyone has access to the arts. The mission is also to preserve as much of the 42-acre site in its natural, forested condition as possible, with trails for the community to enjoy.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The funds will be used to construct a Community Amphitheater attached to a building. The Community Amphitheater will be a performance outdoor space, and the building will house offices and community arts classroom area. The project will include electrical, water and sewer infrastructure, landscaping, road improvements, sidewalks and pedestrian walkways. The Community Amphitheater is the first building of a planned arts campus, located on 42 acres of property located in the densely populated and intensely zoned area of Harford County, located 5 minutes from I-95. The Property was donated to the Maryland Center for the Visual and Performing Arts by the Emily Bayliss Graham Foundation.
