10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)

The Maryland State Fair & Agricultural Society, Inc. is a 501(c)3 non-profit who's mission is to support, educate, preserve, and promote Maryland agriculture. As such the organization holds the annual state fair, providing a showplace for the best in Maryland agriculture. The organization also supports the next generation of agriculture partnering with the 4-H and FFA programs in the state. Throughout the year the campus acts as a gathering place for various shows, exhibits and community events. The fair annual welcomes over 2 million visitors and serves as a valuable community resource offering free use of the facilities to local and state fire, police, and first responders. The Fair also host meetings for two local community organizations.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

As a large community gathering place safety and accessibility is a primary concern. Several of the buildings on campus are older and require renovation to improve their safety and accessibility features. The Administration Building host community meetings as well as police and fire trainings. It serves as a community resource for weddings, baby showers, birthday parties and many other activities. The second level is only accessible by a back ramp. The Fair would like to install an elevator to increase the safety and accessibility of this valuable community asset. Similarly the Exhibition Hall front hasn't been renovated for over 30 years. There are newer and safer security window and doors that could improve the safety and functionality of the space. This space is annually used by the Maryland Lottery and dozens of other shows and community events.
