The WISP resort is very supportive at the base of the Mountain and does provide the NSP with some of the necessary supplies to provide great pre hospital care. However the top of the Mountain peak is antiquated and in serous need of finical help. We need the ability to offer the same patient care as the base clinic provides. Our current building is in need of an aid room and equipment, updated electricity, running water for wound care management and storage for our equipment which is left outside year around in the weather. Our current building needs updates to be able support the level of patient care that our patrol is capable of providing. The current Peak building houses 6-8 patrollers at any given time. We have no running water, reliable heat, bathroom facilities to offer to an injured patient and or family in need. This update to our building would allow us to be the professional organization we strive to be. The peak building provides no incentive for the WISP to invest in at this time. This grant will allow us to provide a much higher level of care. Being Marylands only Ski Resort we hope that others involved in the decision making see that this wold be a huge investment in the future for all Maryland residents.
