Throughout the State of MD, there are over 150,000 residents ages 18-64 that have cognitive disabilities and only 38% are employed. As part of a working bakery and culinary kitchen, Sunflower Bakery enables these pathways to employment through pre-employment exposure and workforce development training in Pastry Arts, Hospitality, and, is now offering Culinary Arts. Since 2009, Sunflower has impacted the lives of over 616 young adults with learning differences.

Sunflowers training model is experiential and we incorporate our students in everything we make or sell. As Sunflower Bakery expands our workforce development training and food offerings, we need to increase our capacity in our social enterprise. To enable this growth, Sunflower Bakery seeks funding for a delivery vehicle for delivery of our bakery and culinary products. We piloted a Culinary training program last year and now have a new commercial kitchen facility where we are training culinary students who will be producing glatt kosher prepared foods including soups, sandwiches, salads and meals with plans to provide catering. A reefer vehicle will allow Sunflower to safely transport foods that require a temperature-controlled environment
