## **10. Description and Purpose of Organization** (Limit length to visible area)

The City of College Park is a municipality in Prince George's County with 35,000 residents is unique neighborhoods and the University of Maryland. For more than 50 years the City has operated a Youth, Family, and Senior Services Department. This Department provides community-based programs that strengthen residents social, emotional and mental well-being. City Youth, Family and Senior Initiatives include the Lakeland STARs tutoring program, a City-wide online tutoring program, summer camp scholarships, emergency assistance funds, holiday donations, legislative advocacy, support of the Education Advisory Committee, Senior Advisory Committee and AARP Livable Community Action Plan. Youth and Family Services offers family counseling, parenting and support groups, therapeutic youth groups and outreach services for youth and families with children ages 2-18.

## 11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The main Youth and Family Services building is 29 years old. Staff have discussed various ways that the grounds could be improved to provide quiet space for clients and a more attractive space for everyone. In January 2024 the City contracted with Nature Sacred in Annapolis to design concept plans for seating areas, a meditative garden, and / or other features for clients and the public. The design meetings kicked off in May 2024 and final design plans will be available in April 2025. The City requests funding to assist with the construction of the project once the design is complete this spring. The cost estimate is approximate and could change based on the selection of the final design.
