House Bill 410 (Delegate Pruski)
Economic Matters

Anne Arundel County – Board of License Commissioners – Chief Inspector – Compensation

This bill modifies the pay schedule of the full-time chief inspector employed by the Anne Arundel County Board of License Commissioners from non-represented pay schedule NR-05 to non-represented pay schedule NR-15 in the general county classified salary schedule. **The bill takes effect July 1, 2025.**

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill only affects local government operations.

Local Effect: The bill is not expected to materially affect Anne Arundel County finances or operations.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: Chapter 668 of 2021 required the Anne Arundel County Board of License Commissioners to replace its part-time chief inspector position with a full-time chief inspector position with a salary in non-represented pay schedule NR-05 in the general county classified salary schedule.

Additional Comments: According to Anne Arundel County’s fiscal 2025 non-represented pay schedule, an NR-05 salary is between \$35,318 and \$63,445. An NR-15 salary is between \$57,876 and \$103,971. Generally, the board is responsible for funding its own operations, including salaries of inspectors, using revenue from license

fees. While the bill modifies the pay schedule for the full-time chief inspector, it does not directly require the board to increase or decrease the chief inspector's salary.

Recent Prior Introductions: Similar legislation has not been introduced within the last three years.
