**Anne Arundel County - Board of License Commissioners - Part-Time Deputy  
Chief Inspector - Compensation**

---

This bill increases, from \$9,000 to \$18,000, the annual salary of the part-time deputy chief inspector employed by the Anne Arundel County Board of License Commissioners. **The bill takes effect July 1, 2025.**

---

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None.

**Local Effect:** Anne Arundel County salary expenditures increase by \$9,000 annually beginning in FY 2026. Anne Arundel County revenues are not affected.

**Small Business Effect:** None.

---

**Analysis**

**Current Law:** The board is authorized to employ a part-time deputy chief inspector and 18 part-time inspectors. In enforcing alcoholic beverage law in Anne Arundel County, an inspector has all the powers of a peace officer or sheriff and may serve a summons and issue a civil citation for a license violation, as specified.

The annual salary of the part-time deputy chief inspector is \$9,000.

**Local Expenditures:** Anne Arundel County expenditures increase by \$9,000 annually beginning in fiscal 2026 due to the increase in annual salary for the part-time deputy chief inspector under the bill.
