(House Bill 399)

AN ACT concerning

**State Retirement and Pension System – Transfers Between Systems –
Workgroup – Extension**

FOR the purpose of extending the reporting date and the termination date for a workgroup convened by the State Retirement Agency to study transfers of member service between State and local retirement and pension systems; altering the entities to which the State Retirement Agency is required to report; and generally relating to transfers of member service between State and local retirement and pension systems.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 768 of the Acts of 2025

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That:

(a) (1) The State Retirement Agency shall convene a workgroup of interested stakeholders to study the requirements and processes for transfers of member service between State and local retirement and pension systems and make recommendations to improve the process of transfers between systems.

(d) On or before [December 1, 2025] **OCTOBER 1, 2026**, the State Retirement Agency shall submit a report of the findings and recommendations of the workgroup,

including the need for any legislative initiatives, to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the [General Assembly] **SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION COMMITTEE, THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE, AND THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON PENSIONS.**

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2025. It shall remain effective for a period of [1 year] **2 YEARS** and 1 month and, at the end of June 30, [2026] **2027**, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

Chapter 769 of the Acts of 2025

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(a) (1) The State Retirement Agency shall convene a workgroup of interested stakeholders to study the requirements and processes for transfers of member service between State and local retirement and pension systems and make recommendations to improve the process of transfers between systems.

(d) On or before [December 1, 2025] **OCTOBER 1, 2026**, the State Retirement Agency shall submit a report of the findings and recommendations of the workgroup, including the need for any legislative initiatives, to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, the [General Assembly] **SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION COMMITTEE, THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE, AND THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON PENSIONS.**

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2025. It shall remain effective for a period of [1 year] **2 YEARS** and 1 month and, at the end of June 30, [2026] **2027**, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2026.
