AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1100
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “prohibiting” in line 6 down through “period,” in line 9; and in line 24, strike “(m) and 17–1010.1” and substitute “10.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 14, strike “TELECOMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT” and substitute “TELECOMMUNICATIONS INFRASTRUCTURE AS DEFINED IN § 6–305.1 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE;

10. ANY OTHER USED ARTICLES OWNED BY A TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANY, AS DEFINED IN § 6–305.1 OF THE CRIMINAL LAW ARTICLE, INCLUDING:

A. BURNED WIRES;

B. BUSBARS;

C. POWER INVERTERS; AND

D. MATERIALS WITH IDENTIFIABLE MARKERS THAT INDICATE OWNERSHIP BY THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMPANY.”;

and in line 15, strike “10.” and substitute “11.”.

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 24 on page 2 through line 24 on page 3, inclusive.

On page 4, in line 9, after “OPTIC” insert “AND COPPER”;

On page 5, in line 1, strike “FELONY” and substitute “MISDEMEANOR”; and in line 3, strike “\$5,000” and substitute “\$500”.
