AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2100, AS AMENDED
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Strike the Government, Labor, and Elections Committee Amendment (HB2100/923921/1) in its entirety.

On page 1 of the bill, in line 2, strike “**General Assembly and Representatives in Congress**” and substitute “**Prohibition on Mid-Cycle Congressional Districting**”; strike beginning with “clarifying” in line 3 down through “plan” in line 8 and substitute “prohibiting the General Assembly, except under certain circumstances, from adopting a congressional districting plan more than once every certain number of years immediately following the decennial census”; and strike in their entirety lines 9 through 11, inclusive.

On pages 1 through 2 of the bill, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 15 on page 1 through line 9 on page 2, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2 of the bill, strike in their entirety lines 14 through 18, inclusive; and strike in their entirety lines 20 through 25, inclusive, and substitute:

“UNLESS THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IS REQUIRED TO ADOPT A NEW CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTING PLAN BY A COURT ORDER, FOR THE PURPOSE OF DIVIDING THE STATE INTO DISTRICTS FOR THE ELECTION OF THE STATE’S REPRESENTATIVES IN CONGRESS, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY NOT ADOPT A CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTING PLAN MORE THAN ONCE EVERY 10 YEARS IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING EACH DECENNIAL CENSUS.”

On page 3 of the bill, in line 3, strike “(1)”; and strike in their entirety lines 7 through 15, inclusive.
