AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 100
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after “**Stops**” insert “**and Accessibility**”; in line 3, after “requiring” insert “**early voting centers to be accessible to certain voters in accordance with a certain federal law; requiring**”; in line 4, strike “the entrance of” and substitute “**a certain location near**”; strike in their entirety lines 11 through 15, inclusive; in line 18, strike “10–301.1(e), (f), and (g)” and substitute “**10–301.1(d)(1) and (e) through (g)**”; and after line 20, insert:

“BY adding to

Article - Election Law

Section 10-301.1(e)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2022 Replacement Volume and 2025 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 5, insert:

“(d) (1) Each early voting center shall:

(I) SUBJECT TO ITEM (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, satisfy the requirements of § 10–101 of this title; AND

(II) BE ACCESSIBLE TO VOTERS WITH PHYSICAL DISABILITIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT.”

in line 17, after “(2)” insert “(I)”; in the same line, strike “IF” and substitute “SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, IF”; strike beginning with “AND” in line 19 down through “REQUIREMENTS” in line 20; and after line 22, insert:

“(II) WHEN STOPPING UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE BUS SHALL, TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PRACTICABLE AND CONSISTENT WITH TRAFFIC LAWS AND SAFETY STANDARDS, STOP AT A LOCATION THAT PROVIDES AN ACCESSIBLE PATH TO THE ENTRANCE DOORS OF THE EARLY VOTING CENTER.”.
