AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2100  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, strike “and”; in line 8, after “plan” insert “; and requiring the Attorney General to certify that a congressional districting plan of the State complies with certain precedent before the plan may take effect”; and after line 14, insert:

“BY proposing an addition to the Maryland Constitution  
New Article XXI - Certification of Congressional Districts  
Section 1”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 25, insert:

**“ARTICLE XXI – CERTIFICATION OF CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS**

**1.**

**BEFORE A CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTING PLAN OF THE STATE MAY TAKE EFFECT, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL CERTIFY THAT THE CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTING PLAN COMPLIES WITH APPLICABLE PRECEDENT ESTABLISHED BY THE SUPREME COURT OF THE UNITED STATES EXISTING AT THE TIME OF THE CERTIFICATION.**”.

On page 3, in line 13, strike “and”; and in line 15, after “laws” insert “; and requires the Attorney General to certify that a congressional districting plan of the State complies with applicable precedent established by the Supreme Court of the United States before the plan may take effect”.
