AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1182
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**Delegate McCaskill**” and substitute “**Delegates McCaskill, Ebersole, Feldmark, Griffith, Miller, Mireku–North, Palakovich Carr, Pasteur, Patterson, Wilkins, and Wims**”; in line 3, after “of” insert “requiring certain public and nonpublic schools to develop policies and procedures regarding student wandering or elopement behavior;”; in line 12, strike “and 7–11A–02”; after line 14, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
Article - Education
Section 7–11A–02
Annotated Code of Maryland
(2025 Replacement Volume and 2025 Supplement)”;

and in line 22, strike “and 7–11A–04”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 29, insert:

“**(C) A SCHOOL SHALL DEVELOP POLICIES AND PROCEDURES TO IMPLEMENT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.**”.

On page 3, in line 12, strike “**OR BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION**”; in line 13, strike “**AND**”; and in line 19, after “**DEVICE**” insert “**; AND**”

(3) THE LOCATIVE DEVICE:

(1) IS INCAPABLE OF MAKING AUDIO OR VIDEO RECORDINGS OF OTHER STUDENTS OR SCHOOL PERSONNEL; OR

(II) HAS FEATURES CAPABLE OF AUDIO OR VIDEO RECORDING TURNED OFF WHEN THE STUDENT IS IN AN EDUCATIONAL SETTING".

On page 4, in lines 4 and 5 and 16 and 17, in each instance, strike "OR BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION"; in line 20, strike "SHALL" and substitute ":

(I) SHALL";

in line 23, after "SECTION" insert "**;** AND

(II) MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED AS LEGAL ADVICE ABOUT THE FEDERAL ADMINISTRATION OF FEDERAL PRIVACY LAW";

and in line 24, after "(E)" insert "**A SCHOOL MAY DEVELOP POLICIES AND PROCEDURES TO IMPLEMENT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.**

(F)".

On pages 4 and 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 30 on page 4 through line 6 on page 5, inclusive.
