AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1372  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, after “Committee)” insert “and Delegates Alston, Bagnall, Cullison, Guzzone, Hill, Hutchinson, Kaufman, Kipke, Lopez, Martinez, M. Morgan, Reilly, Rosenberg, Ross, Taveras, White Holland, and Woorman”; in line 3, strike “Department of”; in line 7, strike “Department of”; in line 9, after the first “the” insert “Maryland”; in the same line, after “Department” insert “of Health”; and strike beginning with “the” in line 10 down through “boards” in line 11 and substitute “each health occupations board to annually report certain information to the Department of Information Technology”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 3, after “INSPECTION;” insert “AND”; strike beginning with “THE” in line 4 down through “(IV)” in line 5; in lines 20 and 21, in each instance, strike “DEPARTMENT OF”; and strike beginning with “IMPROVE” in line 24 down through “RELATIONSHIP” in line 25 and substitute “INCREASE COLLABORATION”.

On page 4, strike beginning with “THE” in line 13 down through “DESIGNEE” in line 15 and substitute “THREE MEMBERS WHO ARE THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS, OR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS’ DESIGNEES, OF HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARDS NOT OTHERWISE REPRESENTED ON THE COMMISSION, DESIGNATED JOINTLY BY THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARDS NOT OTHERWISE REPRESENTED ON THE COMMISSION”; in line 16, strike “SECRETARY” and substitute “COCHAIRS”; in line 17, strike “SECRETARY DETERMINES” and substitute “COCHAIRS, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARDS, DETERMINE”; in line 19, strike “THE SECRETARY, OR THE SECRETARY’S DESIGNEE, SHALL CHAIR” and substitute “THE MEMBER OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND AND THE MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF”.

DELEGATES APPOINTED UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION SHALL COCHAIR"; in line 21, after "DEPARTMENT" insert "OF LEGISLATIVE SERVICES"; in line 24, strike "SERVE AS A LIAISON TO" and substitute "BE AVAILABLE TO WORK WITH"; and in line 26, after "10" insert "BUSINESS".

On page 5, strike beginning with "REGARDING" in line 6 down through "DEPARTMENT" in line 7; in line 25, strike "SECRETARY" and substitute "COMMISSION"; and in line 26, strike "HOW BEST TO";

On pages 5 and 6, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 27 on page 5 through line 3 on page 6, inclusive, and substitute:

**"(I) ESTABLISHING A COMPREHENSIVE LICENSURE SYSTEM THAT MAY BE USED BY A HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD;**

**"(II) AUTHORIZING A HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD THAT USES THE COMPREHENSIVE LICENSURE SYSTEM TO USE LICENSE FEES TO SUPPORT THE SYSTEM;"**.

On page 6, in line 4, strike "CONSOLIDATE" and substitute "CONSOLIDATING"; in line 8, strike "INCREASE" and substitute "INCREASING"; in line 12, strike "OCTOBER" and substitute "DECEMBER"; strike in their entirety lines 19 through 21, inclusive, and substitute:

**"ON OR BEFORE JULY 1 EACH YEAR, EACH HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD SHALL CERTIFY TO THE SECRETARY OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY THAT THE INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SYSTEMS USED BY THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS BOARD MEET THE STATE MINIMUM CYBERSECURITY REQUIREMENTS.**

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Maryland Health Centralization Commission established under § 1-103 of the Health Occupations Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, shall hold its first meeting on or before July 1, 2026.”;

and in line 22, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
