AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 192
(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, strike “membership” and substitute “representation”; and in line 19, strike “and” and substitute “, 9-932, and”.

On page 2, in line 4, after “9-917,” insert “9-918, 9-926, 9-927, 9-935.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 5, in line 19, strike “and a veteran”.

On page 6, after line 10, insert:

“9-918.

(a) From among the members of the Commission, the Governor shall appoint a [chairman] CHAIR.

(b) A vice [chairman] CHAIR shall be elected by a simple majority vote of the Commission.

9-926.

(a) From among its members, the Veterans’ Home Commission shall elect a [chairman] CHAIR, a secretary, and any other officers that the Commission considers appropriate.

(b) The manner of election of officers and their terms of office shall be as the Veterans’ Home Commission determines.

9-927.

(a) Seven members of the Veterans' Home Commission are a quorum to do business.

(b) (1) The Veterans' Home Commission shall meet:

(i) at least twice a year, at the times and places that it determines; and

(ii) at the call of the [Chairman] CHAIR, on the [Chairman's] CHAIR'S initiative or on the request of at least 4 members.

(2) Unless all of the members of the Veterans' Home Commission agree otherwise, the secretary of the Commission shall give each member at least 7 days' written notice of a meeting.

(3) If the President is unable to attend a meeting, the President may designate a Senator or an employee of the General Assembly to represent the President at the meeting.

(4) If the Speaker is unable to attend a meeting, the Speaker may designate a Delegate or an employee of the General Assembly to represent the Speaker at the meeting.

(5) If the Governor is unable to attend a meeting, the Governor may designate another individual to represent the Governor at the meeting.

(c) A member of the Veterans' Home Commission:

(1) may not receive compensation; but

(2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

9-932.

In this Part IV of this subtitle, "Commission" means the War Memorial Commission.

9-935.

(a) From among its members, the Commission may elect:

(1) a [chairman] CHAIR;

(2) a vice [chairman] CHAIR; and

(3) a secretary and a treasurer or a secretary-treasurer.

(b) The manner of election of officers and their terms of office shall be as the Commission determines."

On page 7, in lines 2 and 3, strike "**MEMBER, APPOINTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AND MILITARY FAMILIES**" and substitute "**MEMBER**".
