AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 444, AS AMENDED
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Strike in their entirety the Judiciary Committee Amendments (HB0444/993029/1).

On page 1 of the bill, in line 2, strike “**Public Safety – Immigration Enforcement Agreements – Prohibition**” and substitute “**Correctional Services – Immigration Enforcement – Required Notice and Transfer**”; strike beginning with “prohibiting” in line 3 down through “date” in line 7 and substitute “requiring an employee or agent of a State or local correctional facility to provide certain notice of the release of an individual and transfer the individual to federal immigration authorities under certain circumstances”; and strike in their entirety lines 8 through 12, inclusive, and substitute:

“BY adding to

Article – Correctional Services
Section 9–309
Annotated Code of Maryland
(2025 Replacement Volume)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2 of the bill, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 15 on page 1 through line 19 on page 2, inclusive, and substitute:

“Article – Correctional Services

9–309.

IF REQUESTED BY FEDERAL IMMIGRATION AUTHORITIES, AN EMPLOYEE
OR AGENT OF A STATE OR LOCAL CORRECTIONAL FACILITY SHALL:

(1) PROVIDE NOTICE OF THE RELEASE OF AN INDIVIDUAL AT
LEAST 48 HOURS PRIOR TO THE RELEASE OF THE INDIVIDUAL IN ORDER TO
FACILITATE THE TRANSFER OF THE INDIVIDUAL TO FEDERAL IMMIGRATION
AUTHORITIES; AND

(2) TRANSFER THE INDIVIDUAL TO FEDERAL IMMIGRATION
AUTHORITIES PROVIDED THAT THE TRANSFER DOES NOT EXTEND THE TIME IN
CUSTODY OF THE INDIVIDUAL BEYOND THE INDIVIDUAL'S SCHEDULED
RELEASE.”.
