AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 284
(First Reading File Bill – Committee Reprint)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 24, after “Account;” insert “establishing the State Highway Administration Roads and Bridges Account within the Transportation Trust Fund; requiring a certain portion of the motor vehicle registration fees be credited to the State Highway Administration Roads and Bridges Account;”.

On page 6, in line 34, after “Section” insert “3–216(a) and (b) and”; and in line 39, after “Section” insert “3–216(c)(2)(i) and”.

On page 7, after line 2, insert:

“BY adding to

Article - Transportation

Section 3–216(d)(6)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2020 Replacement Volume and 2025 Supplement)

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Chapter 717 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2024

Section 22”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 47, after line 15, insert:

“Article – Transportation

3–216.

(a) There is a Transportation Trust Fund for the Department.

(b) Except as otherwise expressly provided by statute, there shall be credited to the Transportation Trust Fund for the account of the Department all taxes, fees, charges, and revenues collected or received by or paid, appropriated, or credited to the account of the Department or any of its units in the exercise of their rights, powers, duties, or obligations, including the cash proceeds of the sale of consolidated transportation bonds, notes, or other evidences of obligation issued by the Department, any General Fund appropriations, and the proceeds of any State loan or federal grant made for transportation purposes.

(c) (2) (i) The Gasoline and Motor Vehicle Revenue Account, the Driver Education Account, the Motorcycle Safety Program Account, [and] the Transportation Network Company Impact Fee Account, AND THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION ROADS AND BRIDGES ACCOUNT shall be maintained in the Transportation Trust Fund.

(d) (6) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ALLOCATE THE FUNDS IN THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION ROADS AND BRIDGES ACCOUNT TO THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION ONLY FOR PROJECTS AND MAINTENANCE RELATED TO ROADS AND BRIDGES.

Chapter 717 of the Acts of 2024

SECTION 22. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That [the]:

(A) THE transportation revenues raised in accordance with the provisions of this Act shall remain allocated within the Department of Transportation.

(B) Notwithstanding § 8-402 of the Transportation Article or any other provision of law, the revenue increases attributable to alterations to the registration fees in Section 2 of this Act:

(1) may not be credited to the Gasoline and Motor Vehicle Revenue Account; AND

(2) SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE STATE HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION ROADS AND BRIDGES ACCOUNT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2027 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER.

(C) Nothing in this section is intended to prohibit the Department of Transportation from providing grants to local governments to restore transportation aid.”.
