AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 165, AS AMENDED
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Strike Amendment No. 1 of the Education, Energy, and the Environment Committee Amendments (SB0165/993726/1) in its entirety.

On page 1 of the bill, in line 2, strike “**Requirements for Inspection and**” and substitute “**Study on Necessity of**”; in line 3, strike “**and Implementation Dates**” and substitute “**During Property Transfer Inspections**”; strike beginning with the first “a” in line 4 down through “which” in line 14; and strike beginning with “is” in line 14 down through “Professionals” in line 16 and substitute “to conduct a certain study on the necessity for pump outs of on-site wastewater systems during property transfer inspections”.

On pages 1 and 2 of the bill, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 18 on page 1 through line 3 on page 2, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

Strike Amendment No. 2 of the Education, Energy, and the Environment Committee Amendments in its entirety.

On page 2 of the bill, in line 5, strike “the Laws of Maryland read as follows”; and after line 5, insert:

“(a) The Department of the Environment shall conduct a study on the necessity for pumping services of on-site wastewater systems during property transfer inspections and the environmental benefits of the practice.”

(b) On or before June 1, 2027, the Department of the Environment shall report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article, on the results of the study conducted under subsection (a) of this section.”.

On pages 2 through 5 of the bill, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 6 on page 2 through line 22 on page 5, inclusive.

On page 5 of the bill, in line 23, strike “3.” and substitute “2.”.
