AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 825
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**Senator Hester**” and substitute “**Senators Hester, Attar, Brooks, Carozza, Kagan, and Simonaire**”; and strike in their entirety lines 18 through 20, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 18, after “**CRITICAL**” insert “**INFRASTRUCTURE**”; in line 19, strike “**AND**”; in line 20, after “**(III)**” insert “**THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY;**

(IV) THE NATIONAL GUARD; AND

(V);

in line 21, after the semicolon insert “**AND**”; and strike beginning with “**(I)**” in line 22 down through “**AND**” in line 26.

On page 4, in line 1, strike “**(6)**”; in line 15, after “**CYBERSECURITY**” insert “**OR PHYSICAL**”; in line 24, strike “**STRENGTHENING**” and substitute “**SUPPORTING**”; in line 26, before “**CONDUCTING**” insert “**CONNECTING PRIORITY ASSETS TO RESOURCES FOR**”; in line 29, strike “**SUPPORTING**” and substitute “**IDENTIFYING TECHNICAL AND GRANT OPPORTUNITIES TO SUPPORT**”; and in line 30, after the semicolon insert “**AND**”.

On page 5, strike beginning with “**ASSISTING**” in line 1 down through “**AND**” in line 2 and substitute “**ESTABLISHING MECHANISMS TO SUPPORT SHARED**

LEARNING AND BEST PRACTICES BETWEEN DIFFERENT CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE ASSETS.”; strike in their entirety lines 3 through 5, inclusive; strike beginning with the comma in line 6 down through the comma in line 7; in line 8, after “TO” insert “CASCADING IMPACTS OF”; in line 14, strike the second “AND”; in line 16, after “INFRASTRUCTURE” insert “; AND”

(3) DIRECT CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE CYBERSECURITY EFFORTS ACROSS THE UNITS OF STATE GOVERNMENT.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the General Assembly that nothing in this Act shall be interpreted to supersede, abrogate, modify, limit, or otherwise affect any cybersecurity regulation, requirement, or authority that is currently in effect and that applies to critical infrastructure entities that are under federal, State, or sector-specific regulatory frameworks.”;

in line 16, strike the period; and in line 17, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
