AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 646
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**and Korman**” and substitute “**, Korman, Grammer, Holmes, Lewis, and Odom**”; in line 5, strike “cancel” and substitute “suspend”; in line 6, strike “, subject to a certain exception”; in line 7, after “additional” insert “documentation, written statements, or other materials related to a diagnosis disclosed by a licensee or an applicant or indicated on forms subsequently submitted to the Administration following disclosure and to require”; and in line 11, after “diagnosis;” insert “requiring the Administration to examine its current practices for medical case review and report to the General Assembly by a certain date:”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 25, strike “**THAT REGULATION**” and substitute “**THE REGULATIONS**”.

On page 2, in line 2, strike “**CANCEL**” and substitute “**SUSPEND**”; strike beginning with “**UNLESS**” in line 3 down through “**APPLICANT**” in line 4; in line 6, strike “**TESTING**” and substitute “**:**”

(1) DOCUMENTATION, WRITTEN STATEMENTS, OR OTHER MATERIALS RELATED TO A DIAGNOSIS OF A LICENSEE OR AN APPLICANT OR INDICATED ON FORMS SUBSEQUENTLY SUBMITTED TO THE ADMINISTRATION FOLLOWING DISCLOSURE; AND

(2) TESTING”;

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in line 11, after “BEEN” insert “**REFUSED OR**”; in the same line, strike “**OR CANCELED**”; and in line 22, after “2.” insert “AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:”

(1) on or before December 1, 2026, the Motor Vehicle Administration shall examine its current practices for medical case review;

(2) the examination shall consider current Administration practices in comparison with industry best practices, including streamlining case review and using electronic communication where permissible; and

(3) on or before December 1, 2026, the Motor Vehicle Administration shall report its findings and recommendations under the examination, in accordance with § 2–1257 of the State Government Article, to the General Assembly, including any changes adopted or to be adopted by the Administration as a result of the examination.

SECTION 3.”
