AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1018

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “**Delegate**” and substitute “**Delegates**”; in the same line, after “**Stewart**” insert “, **Crutchfield, Fair, Lehman, Ruth, Schindler, Solomon, Terrasa, and Wu**”; in line 2, before “**Immigration**” insert “**Correctional Facilities and**”; in line 11, after “utilities” insert “, occupancy standards.”; in lines 12 and 13, strike “health care practitioners and security guards” and substitute “persons”; in line 14, after “Commission” insert “or the Office of the Inspector General”; in lines 14 and 15, strike “a health care practitioner or a security guard fails” and substitute “certain persons fail”; in line 19, strike “authorizing” and substitute “requiring”; and in line 20, after “of” insert “a correctional facility or”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, in line 19, strike “State and local”.

On page 6, in line 19, strike “**OR**”; in line 20, after “**(IV)**” insert “**REFER THE VIOLATION TO THE OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION; OR**”

(V)”;

in line 25, strike “**OR**”; and in line 27, after “**ARTICLE**” insert “;

(III) AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN LICENSED UNDER TITLE 13, SUBTITLE 5 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE; OR

(IV) A PRIVATE CUSTODIAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICE”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 7, in line 7, strike “OR” and substitute a comma; in the same line, after “GUARD” insert “, AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN, OR A PRIVATE CUSTODIAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICE”; strike beginning with “HAS” in line 22 down through “CONDITIONING;” in line 23 and substitute “MAINTAINS UTILITY COORDINATION FOR POTABLE WATER, SEWER, AND ELECTRICITY SERVICES;”;

in line 26, strike “AND”; in line 29, after “EMERGENCIES” insert “;

(V) HAS COORDINATION PROTOCOLS WITH LOCAL FIRE DEPARTMENTS AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, AND LOCAL HOSPITALS;

(VI) OPERATES WITHIN THE OCCUPANCY STANDARD ESTABLISHED UNDER THE MINIMUM MANDATORY STANDARDS; AND

(VII) OPERATES WITHIN THE CAPACITY OF AVAILABLE UTILITIES AND EMERGENCY SYSTEMS;

in line 30, strike “A” and substitute “SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, A”; and in the same line, strike “A” and substitute “AN UNREDACTED”.

On page 8, in line 1, after “(II)” insert “A FACILITY MAY REDACT SENSITIVE SECURITY AND INTELLIGENCE INFORMATION TO MAINTAIN INTERNAL SECURITY PROCEDURES AND INVESTIGATIONS.”

(III) A FACILITY MAY PROVIDE A REDACTED COPY OF THE EMERGENCY OPERATION PLAN TO THE PUBLIC.

in line 22, strike “**STATE AND LOCAL**”; in line 25, strike “State and local”; and in line 28, strike the brackets.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 9, in lines 1, 5, and 12, in each instance, strike “State and local”; and in line 2, strike the brackets.

On page 13, in line 20, strike “may” and substitute “**SHALL**”.
