AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 99  
(First Reading File Bill)

On page 6, in line 6, after “(I)” insert “**(1) A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION AND THE BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS SHALL PROVIDE LIVE VIDEO STREAMING OF AN OPEN MEETING IF THE MEETING IS HELD AT:**”

**(I) THE HEADQUARTERS OF A COUNTY BOARD OR THE BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS; OR**

**(II) A LOCATION WHERE A COUNTY BOARD OR THE BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS HELD AT LEAST FIVE MEETINGS DURING THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING CALENDAR YEAR.**

**(2) (I);**

strike beginning with “A” in line 7 down through “UNEDITED” in line 8 and substitute “AN”; and after line 10, insert:

**“(II) A COUNTY BOARD AND THE BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS MAY EDIT AN ARCHIVED VIDEO RECORDING THAT IS REQUIRED TO BE MAINTAINED UNDER THIS SECTION TO REMOVE CONTENT FROM THE RECORDING THAT INVOLVES:**

**1. A PORNOGRAPHIC OR OBSCENE EVENT; OR**

**2. AN INSTANCE WHEN A STUDENT'S PRIVACY IS VIOLATED.**

**(III) IF A COUNTY BOARD OR THE BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS EDITS A RECORDING UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE COUNTY BOARD OR THE BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS SHALL NOTIFY THE OPEN MEETINGS LAW COMPLIANCE BOARD.**

**(3) A COUNTY BOARD OR THE BALTIMORE CITY BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS MAY USE A THIRD-PARTY PROVIDER TO VIEW AND STORE RECORDED VIDEO FOOTAGE."**
