2 **Higher Education – Private Career Schools – Advertising**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of Higher Education to allow certain private
4 career schools to advertise certain information and collect certain contact
5 information before receiving a certificate of approval from the Maryland Higher
6 Education Commission to operate a private career school in the State; and generally
7 relating to private career schools.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 (a) In this division the following words have the meanings indicated.

3 (j) “Private career school” means a privately owned and privately operated
4 institution of postsecondary education other than an institution of higher education that
5 furnishes or offers to furnish programs, whether or not requiring a payment of tuition or
6 fee, for the purpose of training, retraining, or upgrading individuals for gainful employment
7 as skilled or semiskilled workers or technicians in recognized occupations or in new and
8 emerging occupations.

10 (A) **THE SECRETARY MAY APPROVE A REQUEST FROM AN APPLICANT FOR A**
11 **PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL TO ADVERTISE AND COLLECT CONTACT INFORMATION**
12 **FROM POTENTIAL NEW STUDENTS BEFORE THE PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL RECEIVES**
13 **A CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL TO OPERATE.**

14 (B) **A PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL APPROVED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF**
15 **THIS SECTION:**

16 (1) **SHALL:**

17 (I) **ADVERTISE ONLY INFORMATION RELATING TO THE**
18 **OPENING OF THE PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL, INCLUDING THE ANTICIPATED DATE OF**
19 **OPENING, PROGRAMS OF INSTRUCTION, AND THE APPLICATION PROCESS; AND**

20 (II) **INCLUDE, IN ANY ADVERTISEMENT, A DISCLOSURE THAT**
21 **THE CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL TO OPERATE THE PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL IS**
22 **PENDING APPROVAL; AND**

23 (2) **MAY NOT COLLECT ANY FEES OR ENTER INTO AN ENROLLMENT**
24 **AGREEMENT WITH POTENTIAL STUDENTS.**

25 (C) **THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS PROVIDING FOR THE**
26 **PROCESS TO APPROVE A PRIVATE CAREER SCHOOL TO ADVERTISE UNDER THIS**
27 **SECTION.**

28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
29 1, 2026.
