A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Criminal Law – Nondomesticated Animal Prohibitions – Alterations**

3 FOR the purpose of altering a certain exception to the prohibition against importing,
4 offering for sale, trading, bartering, possessing, breeding, or exchanging certain live,
5 nondomesticated animals and repealing a certain other exception; prohibiting
6 certain live nondomesticated animals from being imported, offered for sale, traded,
7 bartered, possessed, bred, or exchanged on or after a certain date, subject to a certain
8 exception; and generally relating to the prohibition against the importation, sale,
9 trade, barter, possession, breeding, or exchange of certain nondomesticated animals.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Criminal Law**

18 10-621.

19 (a) (1) Except as provided in subsection (b)(2) of this section, this section does
20 not apply to:

21 (i) a research facility or federal research facility licensed under the
22 federal Animal Welfare Act;

(iii) a person who possesses a valid license or permit issued by the Department of Natural Resources to import, sell, trade, barter, possess, breed, or exchange an animal specified in subsection (b) of this section;

7 (iv) an animal sanctuary that:

17 (v) an animal control officer under the jurisdiction of the State or a
18 local governing authority, a law enforcement officer acting under the authority of this
19 subtitle, or a private contractor of a county or municipal corporation that is responsible for
20 animal control operations;

(vi) a person who holds a valid license to practice veterinary medicine in the State and treats the animal specified in subsection (b) of this section in accordance with customary and normal veterinary practices;

24 (vii) a person who is not a resident of the State and is in the State for
25 [10 days] **48 HOURS** or less for the purpose of traveling between locations outside of the
26 State; and

(viii) a circus holding a Class C Exhibitor's License under the Animal Welfare Act, 7 U.S.C. § 2131 et seq., that:

1. is in the State for less than 90 days per calendar year;

5 (II) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT A PERSON WHO HAD
6 LAWFUL POSSESSION OF AN ANIMAL SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (B)(1)(IX) OR (X) OF
7 THIS SECTION ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2026, FROM CONTINUING TO POSSESS
8 THAT ANIMAL IF THE PERSON PROVIDES WRITTEN NOTIFICATION TO THE LOCAL
9 ANIMAL CONTROL AUTHORITY ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2026.

11 1. the person's name, address, and telephone number;

12 2. the number and type of animals being kept; and

18 (i) trained to perform tasks for the owner by an organization
19 described in Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code; and

20 (ii) dedicated to improving the quality of life of a person who has a
21 disability that severely limits mobility.]

22 (b) (1) A person may not import into the State, offer for sale, trade, barter,
23 possess, breed, or exchange a live:

24 (i) fox, skunk, raccoon, or bear;

25 (ii) caiman, alligator, or crocodile;

26 (iii) member of the cat family other than the domestic cat;

27 (iv) hybrid of a member of the cat family and a domestic cat if the
28 hybrid weighs over 30 pounds;

29 (v) member of the dog family other than the domestic dog;

30 (vi) hybrid of a member of the dog family and a domestic dog;

(vii) nonhuman primate, including a lemur, monkey, chimpanzee, gorilla, orangutan, marmoset, loris, or tamarin; [or]

(viii) poisonous snake in the family groups of Hydrophidae, Elapidae, Viperidae, or Crotolidae;

5 (IX) KANGAROO, WALLAROO, OR WALLABY; OR

6 (X) ZEBRA.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2026.
