1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicles – Intelligent Speed Assistance System Pilot Program –**
3 **Establishment**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Intelligent Speed Assistance System Pilot Program;
5 ~~requiring~~ authorizing certain individuals whose driver's licenses are subject to
6 certain suspension or revocation to participate in the Program; requiring the Motor
7 Vehicle Administration to issue to participants a restrictive license requiring the use
8 of an intelligent speed assistance system; prohibiting a participant from operating a
9 motor vehicle in violation of the requirements of the Program; requiring the District
10 Court to ensure that certain entries are included in a certain schedule of fines; and
11 generally relating to the Intelligent Speed Assistance System Pilot Program.

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
2 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 **Article – Transportation**

4 16–404.

5 (c) (1) Except as provided in paragraphs (2) [and (3)], **(3), AND (4)** of this
6 subsection:

7 (i) An initial suspension may not be for less than 2 days nor more
8 than 30 days; and

9 (ii) Any subsequent suspension may not be for less than 15 days nor
10 more than 90 days.

11 (2) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (3) of this subsection, the
12 following suspension periods may apply to a suspension for an accumulation of points under
13 § 16–402(a)(29) of this subtitle for a violation of § 21–902(b) or (c) of this article or a
14 suspension imposed under § 16–404.1(f)(1)(iii) of this subtitle:

15 (i) For a first conviction, not more than 6 months;

16 (ii) For a second conviction at least 5 years after the date of the first
17 conviction, not more than 9 months;

18 (iii) For a second conviction less than 5 years after the date of the
19 first conviction or for a third conviction, not more than 12 months; and

20 (iv) For a fourth or subsequent conviction, not more than 24 months.

21 (3) The Administration may issue a restrictive license for the period of the
22 suspension to an individual who participates in the Administration’s Ignition Interlock
23 System Program under § 16–404.1 of this subtitle.

24 **(4) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ISSUE A RESTRICTIVE LICENSE FOR**
25 **THE PERIOD OF THE SUSPENSION AND ANY ADDITIONAL TIME REQUIRED UNDER §**
26 **16–404.2 OF THIS SUBTITLE TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO ~~PARTICIPATES~~ ELECTS TO**
27 **PARTICIPATE IN THE ADMINISTRATION’S INTELLIGENT SPEED ASSISTANCE**

30 Administration to issue a restrictive license or modify a suspension imposed under this

2 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
3 INDICATED.

4 (2) "APPROVED SERVICE PROVIDER" MEANS A PERSON WHO IS
5 CERTIFIED BY:

6 (I) THE ADMINISTRATION TO SERVICE, INSTALL, MONITOR,
7 CALIBRATE, AND PROVIDE INFORMATION ON INTELLIGENT SPEED ASSISTANCE
8 SYSTEMS; AND

9 (II) A MANUFACTURER TO BE QUALIFIED TO SERVICE, INSTALL,
10 MONITOR, CALIBRATE, AND PROVIDE INFORMATION ON INTELLIGENT SPEED
11 ASSISTANCE SYSTEMS.

12 (3) "MANUFACTURER" MEANS A PERSON THAT MANUFACTURES
13 INTELLIGENT SPEED ASSISTANCE SYSTEMS.

14 (4) "PARTICIPANT" MEANS A PARTICIPANT IN THE INTELLIGENT
15 SPEED ASSISTANCE SYSTEM PILOT PROGRAM.

16 (5) "PROGRAM" MEANS THE INTELLIGENT SPEED ASSISTANCE
17 SYSTEM PILOT PROGRAM.

18 (B) (1) ~~THE~~ ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2027, THE ADMINISTRATION
19 SHALL ESTABLISH AN INTELLIGENT SPEED ASSISTANCE SYSTEM PILOT PROGRAM
20 IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.

21 (2) (I) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ESTABLISH A PROTOCOL FOR
22 THE PROGRAM THROUGH THE ADOPTION OF REGULATIONS THAT REQUIRE CERTAIN
23 MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR ALL SERVICE PROVIDERS WHO SERVICE, INSTALL,
24 MONITOR, CALIBRATE, AND PROVIDE INFORMATION ON INTELLIGENT SPEED
25 ASSISTANCE SYSTEMS.

26 (II) THE REGULATIONS SHALL REQUIRE THAT:

27 1. A SERVICE PROVIDER WHO APPLIES TO THE
28 ADMINISTRATION FOR CERTIFICATION AS AN APPROVED SERVICE PROVIDER
29 DEMONSTRATE THAT THE SERVICE PROVIDER IS ABLE TO COMPETENTLY SERVICE,
30 INSTALL, MONITOR, CALIBRATE, AND PROVIDE INFORMATION TO THE
31 ADMINISTRATION AT LEAST EVERY 30 DAYS ON INDIVIDUALS REQUIRED TO USE
32 INTELLIGENT SPEED ASSISTANCE SYSTEMS;

1 2. A SERVICE PROVIDER WHO APPLIES TO THE
2 ADMINISTRATION FOR CERTIFICATION AS AN APPROVED SERVICE PROVIDER BE
3 CERTIFIED BY A SIGNED AFFIDAVIT FROM THE MANUFACTURER THAT THE SERVICE
4 PROVIDER HAS BEEN TRAINED BY AN AUTHORIZED MANUFACTURER AND THAT THE
5 SERVICE PROVIDER IS COMPETENT TO SERVICE, INSTALL, MONITOR, CALIBRATE,
6 AND PROVIDE INFORMATION ON INTELLIGENT SPEED ASSISTANCE SYSTEMS;

7 3. APPROVED SERVICE PROVIDERS BE CONSIDERED TO
8 BE AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES OF THE MANUFACTURER; AND

9 4. ANY SERVICE OF NOTICE ON AN APPROVED SERVICE
10 PROVIDER BE CONSIDERED TO BE SERVICE OF NOTICE ON THE MANUFACTURER
11 WHO CERTIFIED THE APPROVED SERVICE PROVIDER.

12 (c) (1) AN INDIVIDUAL ~~SHALL~~ MAY BE A PARTICIPANT IF THE INDIVIDUAL
13 HAS ACCUMULATED POINTS IN AN AMOUNT THAT WOULD RESULT IN SUSPENSION OR
14 REVOCATION OF ~~A~~ THE INDIVIDUAL'S DRIVER'S LICENSE UNDER § 16-404 OF THIS
15 SUBTITLE DUE TO ANY COMBINATION OF VIOLATIONS OF:

16 (i) ~~§ 16-402(A)(3) OF THIS SUBTITLE;~~

17 (ii) ~~§ 16-402(A)(17) OF THIS SUBTITLE;~~

18 (iii) ~~§ 16-402(A)(24) OF THIS SUBTITLE;~~

26 (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO PARTICIPATES IN THE PROGRAM SHALL BE
27 A PARTICIPANT FOR ~~1 YEAR;~~

28 (i) FOR A FIRST SUSPENSION AS DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION,
29 90 DAYS;

1 **(II) FOR A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT SUSPENSION AS**
2 **DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION, 180 DAYS; AND**

3 **(III) FOR A REVOCATION AS DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION, 1**
4 **YEAR.**

5 **(3) IF AN INDIVIDUAL ~~IS SUBJECT TO THIS SUBSECTION~~ ELECTS TO**
6 **PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM AND FAILS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM OR**
7 **SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE THE PROGRAM, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL SUSPEND,**
8 **NOTWITHSTANDING § 16-208 OF THIS TITLE, THE INDIVIDUAL'S DRIVER'S LICENSE**
9 **~~UNTIL THE INDIVIDUAL SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETES THE PROGRAM~~ IN**
10 **ACCORDANCE WITH § 16-404 OF THIS SUBTITLE.**

11 **(D) (1) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:**

12 **(I) MODIFY A SUSPENSION AND ISSUE A RESTRICTIVE**
13 **DRIVER'S LICENSE REQUIRING THE USE OF AN INTELLIGENT SPEED ASSISTANCE**
14 **SYSTEM FOR THE DURATION OF PROGRAM PARTICIPATION TO A PARTICIPANT WHO**
15 **IS OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE FOR THE LICENSE; AND**

16 **(II) REINSTATE THE DRIVER'S LICENSE, SUBJECT TO A**
17 **RESTRICTION REQUIRING THE USE OF AN INTELLIGENT SPEED ASSISTANCE SYSTEM**
18 **FOR THE DURATION OF PROGRAM PARTICIPATION, OF A PARTICIPANT WHOSE**
19 **DRIVER'S LICENSE HAS BEEN REVOKED.**

20 **(2) A NOTICE OF SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF A DRIVER'S**
21 **LICENSE AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION SENT TO AN**
22 **INDIVIDUAL SHALL INCLUDE INFORMATION ABOUT THE PROGRAM AND HOW**
23 **INDIVIDUALS MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM.**

24 **(3) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ESTABLISH A FEE FOR**
25 **PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM THAT IS SUFFICIENT TO COVER THE COSTS OF**
26 **THE PROGRAM.**

27 **(E) A PARTICIPANT MAY NOT OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE IN VIOLATION OF**
28 **THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE PROGRAM.**

29 **(F) A PARTICIPANT IS CONSIDERED TO HAVE BEGUN PARTICIPATION IN THE**
30 **PROGRAM ON THE DAY THE INTELLIGENT SPEED ASSISTANCE SYSTEM IS INSTALLED**
31 **IN THE PARTICIPANT'S MOTOR VEHICLE.**

32 **(G) (1) AN INDIVIDUAL REQUIRED TO USE AN INTELLIGENT SPEED**
33 **ASSISTANCE SYSTEM UNDER THIS SECTION:**

1 (I) SHALL BE MONITORED BY THE ADMINISTRATION; AND

2 (II) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
3 SUBSECTION, SHALL PAY THE FEE REQUIRED BY THE ADMINISTRATION UNDER
4 SUBSECTION (D)(3) OF THIS SECTION.

5 (2) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL WAIVE THE FEE REQUIRED UNDER
6 THIS SUBSECTION FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS INDIGENT.

7 (H) IF AN INDIVIDUAL COMPLETES THE PROGRAM AND THE INDIVIDUAL'S
8 LICENSE IS NOT REFUSED, REVOKED, SUSPENDED, OR CANCELED UNDER ANOTHER
9 PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL REINSTATE THE
10 INDIVIDUAL'S DRIVER'S LICENSE OR ISSUE IMMEDIATELY A DRIVER'S LICENSE TO
11 THE INDIVIDUAL, AS APPROPRIATE.

12 (I) (1) IF THE ADMINISTRATION REMOVES AN INDIVIDUAL FROM THE
13 PROGRAM BECAUSE THE INDIVIDUAL VIOLATED A REQUIREMENT OF THE
14 PROGRAM, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ALLOW THE INDIVIDUAL TO REENTER THE
15 PROGRAM AFTER A PERIOD OF ~~30~~ 10 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF REMOVAL.

16 (2) IF AN INDIVIDUAL REENTERS THE PROGRAM UNDER THIS
17 SUBSECTION, THE INDIVIDUAL SHALL PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM FOR 3
18 MONTHS IN ADDITION TO THE PERIOD OF TIME THAT WAS NECESSARY FOR
19 SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE PROGRAM AT THE TIME THE INDIVIDUAL WAS
20 REMOVED FROM THE PROGRAM.

21 (J) (1) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY
22 OUT THIS SECTION.

23 (2) THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL
24 INCLUDE REQUIREMENTS FOR A PARTICIPANT TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE
25 EQUIPPED WITH AN INTELLIGENT SPEED ASSISTANCE SYSTEM IN A SAFE MANNER,
26 AS DETERMINED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the District Court shall
28 ensure that the fine schedule for certain violations of the Maryland Vehicle Law includes
29 separate entries for § 21-901.1(a)(1), (2), and (3) of the Transportation Article.

30 SECTION ~~2~~ 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 30,
31 ~~2029~~ 2030, the Motor Vehicle Administration shall report to the Governor and, in
32 accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly on the
33 implementation of this Act, including:

- 1 (1) a description of the Intelligent Speed Assistance System Pilot Program;
- 2 and
- 3 (2) the number of individuals who:
 - 4 (i) were eligible to participate in the Pilot Program through
 - 5 September 30, 2030;
 - 6 (ii) participated in the Pilot Program through September 30, 2030;
 - 7 (iii) participated as a result of:
 - 8 1. a first suspension as described in this Act;
 - 9 2. a second or subsequent suspension as described in this
 - 10 Act; and
 - 11 3. a revocation as described in this Act;
 - 12 (iv) 1. elected to participate in the Pilot Program and failed to
 - 13 participate in the Pilot Program;
 - 14 2. failed to successfully complete the Pilot Program; and
 - 15 3. reentered the Pilot Program; and
 - 16 (v) successfully completed the Pilot Program through September 30,
 - 17 2030.

18 SECTION ~~3~~ 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2026. It shall remain effective for a period of ~~3~~ 4 years and 9 months and, at the
20 end of June 30, ~~2030~~ 2031, this Act, with no further action required by the General
21 Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
