A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Buildings and State Highways – Collection and Disposal of Yard Waste**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from disposing of yard waste collected on the
4 grounds of a State building or State highway in a certain container; requiring a
5 person to collect yard waste on the grounds of a State building or State highway in
6 a certain container; requiring all yard waste collected on the grounds of a State
7 building or State highway to be disposed of in a certain manner under certain
8 circumstances; and generally relating to the collection and disposal of yard waste
9 from the grounds of State buildings and State highways.

11 Article – State Finance and Procurement

12 Section 2–1001 and 2–1002 to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 10. Collection and
13 Disposal of Yard Waste”

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – State Finance and Procurement**

19 **SUBTITLE 10. COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF YARD WASTE.**

20 **2–1001.**

21 **(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
22 INDICATED.**

3 (C) "ORGANICS RECYCLING FACILITY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN §
4 9-1701 OF THE ENVIRONMENT ARTICLE.

5 (D) (1) "STATE BUILDING" MEANS A BUILDING, A STRUCTURE, OR AN
6 IMPROVED AREA THAT IS:

7 (I) OWNED BY THE STATE; OR

8 (II) CONSTRUCTED FOR LEASE BY THE STATE.

10 (I) AN EDUCATIONAL FACILITY OWNED OR OPERATED BY THE
11 STATE, INCLUDING PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION;

12 (II) A PUBLIC MASS TRANSPORTATION ACCOMMODATION, SUCH
13 AS A TERMINAL OR STATION, THAT IS SUPPORTED BY STATE FUNDS; AND

17 (E) (1) "STATE HIGHWAY" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 8-101 OF THE
18 TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.

21 (F) (1) "YARD WASTE" MEANS ORGANIC PLANT WASTE DERIVED FROM
22 GARDENING, LANDSCAPING, AND TREE TRIMMING ACTIVITIES.

25 2-1002.

26 (A) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION,
27 THIS SECTION APPLIES TO A PERSON WHO:

9 (I) NOXIOUS WEEDS, AS DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF
10 AGRICULTURE; OR

11 (II) INVASIVE SPECIES.

12 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT DISPOSE OF YARD WASTE COLLECTED ON THE
13 GROUNDS OF A STATE BUILDING OR STATE HIGHWAY IN A SINGLE-USE PLASTIC
14 CONTAINER.

15 (C) A PERSON SHALL COLLECT YARD WASTE ON THE GROUNDS OF A STATE
16 BUILDING OR STATE HIGHWAY IN A CONTAINER THAT:

(1) WILL NOT BE DISCARDED WITH THE YARD WASTE; OR

18 (2) IS A COMPOSTABLE PAPER BAG.

19 (D) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IF A PERSON COLLECTS YARD
20 WASTE AT A LOCATION THAT IS WITHIN A 30-MILE RADIUS OF A FACILITY THAT:

21 (I) IS IDENTIFIED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
22 SUBSECTION; AND

23 (II) 1. HAS THE CAPACITY TO ACCEPT ALL OF THE PERSON'S
24 YARD WASTE; AND

29 (I) AN ORGANICS RECYCLING FACILITY LOCATED IN THE
30 STATE:

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2026.
