5 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning
6 Commission and the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission to accept as a
7 registered vendor any person that is registered as a vendor with Montgomery County
8 or Prince George's County; authorizing the Maryland–National Capital Park and
9 Planning Commission and the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission to enter
10 into certain memoranda of understanding with Montgomery County and Prince
11 George's County; and generally relating to procurement by the Maryland–National
12 Capital Park and Planning Commission and the Washington Suburban Sanitary

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Land Use

14–101.

(a) In this division the following words have the meanings indicated.

(b) “Commission” means the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission.

15–206.

(A) THE COMMISSION SHALL ACCEPT AS A REGISTERED VENDOR FOR THE COMMISSION ANY PERSON THAT IS REGISTERED AS A VENDOR THROUGH A VENDOR REGISTRATION PROCESS IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY OR PRINCE GEORGE’S COUNTY.
