1 AN ACT concerning

Forestry Licenses – Applicant Qualifications – Alterations

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that an institution from which an applicant for a forestry
4 license graduates on completion of a certain curriculum has certain approval and
5 accreditation; and generally relating to requirements for forestry licenses.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Business Occupations and Professions

14 7–304.

15 (a) To qualify for a license, an applicant shall be an individual who meets the
16 requirements of this section.

17 (b) An applicant shall have graduated on completion of a 4–year curriculum in
18 forestry from a college or university that is:

19 (1) approved by the Board [or]; AND

20 (2) accredited by:

21 (I) the Society of American Foresters; OR

1 (II) AN EQUIVALENT ACCREDITING ENTITY.

2 (c) The applicant shall have at least 2 years of experience in forestry that
3 indicates to the Board that the applicant is competent to practice forestry.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 October 1, 2026.
