A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Highway Administration – Urban Core and Urban Center Traffic Control**
3 **Devices – No Turn on Red**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Highway Administration to install traffic control
5 devices prohibiting right turns on a steady red signal at certain intersections on
6 State highways in urban cores and urban centers; and generally relating to traffic
7 control devices in urban cores and urban centers.

23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
24 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

25 **Article – Transportation**

2 **(A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, ON OR**
3 **BEFORE JULY 1, 2029, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL INSTALL A TRAFFIC CONTROL**
4 **DEVICE PROHIBITING A VEHICLE FROM MAKING A RIGHT TURN WHILE FACING A**
5 **STEADY RED SIGNAL AT EACH INTERSECTION ON A STATE HIGHWAY IN AN URBAN**
6 **CORE OR URBAN CENTER, AS DESCRIBED IN THE ADMINISTRATION'S CONTEXT**
7 **DRIVEN GUIDE, AT WHICH A TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL IS IN USE.**

8 **(B) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY CHOOSE NOT TO INSTALL A TRAFFIC**
9 **CONTROL DEVICE UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION AT A SPECIFIC**
10 **INTERSECTION IF THE ADMINISTRATION DETERMINES THAT THE INSTALLATION**
11 **WOULD SIGNIFICANTLY IMPAIR PUBLIC SAFETY.**

13 “Traffic control device” means any sign, signal, marking, or device that:

14 (1) Is not inconsistent with the Maryland Vehicle Law; and

15 (2) Is placed by authority of an authorized public body or official to
16 regulate, warn, or guide traffic.

18 “Traffic control signal” means any traffic control device, whether manually,
19 electrically, or mechanically operated, by which traffic alternately is directed to stop and
20 permitted to proceed.

21 21-202.

22 (i) Unless a [sign] **TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE** prohibiting a turn is in place,
23 vehicular traffic facing a steady red signal, after stopping as required by subsection (h) of
24 this section, cautiously may enter the intersection and make:

25 (1) A right turn; or

26 (2) A left turn from a one-way street onto a one-way street.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
28 October 1, 2026.
