2 **Anne Arundel County – Board of License Commissioners and Part-Time**
3 **Inspectors – Compensation**

4 FOR the purpose of increasing the annual salaries and providing for cost-of-living salary
5 increases for the chair, certain part-time inspectors, and other members of the Board
6 of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County; and generally relating to
7 alcoholic beverages and the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel
8 County.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,
10 Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis
11 Section 11–101(a) and (b) and 11–102
12 Annotated Code of Maryland

6 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 7 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

8 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages and Cannabis**

9 11–101.

10 (a) In this title:

11 (1) the definitions in § 1–101 of this article apply without exception or
 12 variation; and

13 (2) the following words have the meanings indicated.

14 (b) “Board” means the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County.

15 11–102.

16 This title applies only in Anne Arundel County.

17 11–204.

18 (a) (1) The chair of the Board shall receive:

19 (I) an annual salary [of] **THAT:**

20 1. IS not [more] **LESS** than [\$18,000] **\$21,240**; and

21 2. **INCLUDES ANY COST-OF-LIVING INCREASE**
 22 **AVAILABLE TO NONREPRESENTED ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY NONREPRESENTED**
 23 **EMPLOYEES; AND**

24 (II) reimbursement for expenses reasonably incurred.

25 (2) Each other member of the Board shall receive:

26 (I) an annual salary [of] **THAT:**

27 1. IS not [more] **LESS** than [\$15,000] **\$17,700**; and

1 **2. INCLUDES ANY COST-OF-LIVING INCREASE**
2 **AVAILABLE TO NONREPRESENTED ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY ~~NONREPRESENTED~~**
3 **EMPLOYEES; AND**

4 **(II)** reimbursement for expenses reasonably incurred.

6 (a) (1) The Board may employ:

7 (i) one part-time deputy chief inspector at an annual salary [of]
8 **THAT:**

9 **1. IS NOT LESS THAN \$18,000; and**

10 **2. INCLUDES ANY COST-OF-LIVING INCREASE**
11 **AVAILABLE TO NONREPRESENTED ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY ~~NONREPRESENTED~~**
12 **EMPLOYEES; AND**

13 (ii) 18 part-time inspectors at an annual salary [of \$7,000] **THAT:**

14 **1. IS NOT LESS THAN \$8,260 each; AND**

15 **2. INCLUDES ANY COST-OF-LIVING INCREASE**
16 **AVAILABLE TO NONREPRESENTED ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY ~~NONREPRESENTED~~**
17 **EMPLOYEES.**

18 (2) Each inspector shall receive a monthly expense allowance of \$300,
19 subject to the approval of the Executive Director.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
21 1, 2026.
