12 diem beer license and a Class C per diem beer and wine license, the fee is [~~\$75~~] **\$100** per
13 day.

14 (2) (i) For a club holding a gaming event, the fee is [~~\$100~~] **\$125** per
15 day.

16 (3) For a Class D (3–day) beer and wine license, the fee is [~~\$100~~] **\$125** per
17 day.

18 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, for a Class C per
19 diem beer, wine, and liquor license, the fee is [~~\$200~~] **\$225** per day.

20 (2) (i) For a club holding a gaming event, the fee is [~~\$150~~] **\$175** per
21 day.

22 (3) For a Class C (3–day) beer, wine, and liquor license, the fee is [~~\$200~~]
23 **\$225** per day.

25 (a) The Board shall charge an application fee for a new license.

26 (c) The application fee is [~~\$300~~] **\$400** and in addition to any other fee required
27 for a license.
