A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Public Schools – Career Ladder – Teacher Classroom Teaching Time**

3 FOR the purpose of altering certain requirements of the career ladder for educators to
4 increase the required percentage of working time a certain teacher must spend
5 teaching in the classroom; and generally relating to the career ladder and teacher
6 classroom teaching time.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Education**

20 6–1002.

21 (b) (1) There is a career ladder for educators in the State.

22 (f) The levels of the career ladder are as follows:

23 (1) Level one is a State certified teacher;

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



(2) Level two is a teacher pursuing:

- (i) A master's degree;
- (ii) 30 credits of a program of study approved by the State Board, in with the Professional Standards and Teacher Education Board; or
- (iii) NBC;

(3) Level three is:

- (i) An NBC teacher;
- (ii) If there is no assessment comparable to NBC for the teacher's a teacher with a master's degree in the teacher's subject area; or
- (iii) An assistant principal; and

(4) Level four is:

- (i) A teacher on the teacher leadership track, in the following tiers:
 1. Lead Teacher;
 2. Distinguished Teacher; or
 3. Professor Distinguished Teacher; or
- (ii) A teacher on the administrator track, in the following tiers:
 1. Licensed Principal; or
 2. Distinguished Principal.

Beginning with teachers listed under § 6-1002(h)(3) of this subtitle, as the State Board, a teacher on level one, two, or three of the career ladder shall:

- (1) Teach in the classroom on average **[60%] 80%** of the teacher's working
- (2) Spend the remaining time on other teacher activities, including:
 - (i) Improving instruction;

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
7 1, 2026.
