1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Real Property – New Home Sales – Entry of Final Sale Price in Multiple Listing**
3 **Service**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a developer, builder, broker, or real estate agent to enter the
5 final sale price of a new home into a multiple listing service or similarly accessible
6 database; and generally relating to the sale of new homes.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Real Property**

15 **10–804.**

16 (A) IN THIS SECTION, “MULTIPLE LISTING SERVICE” MEANS A DATABASE
17 USED BY REAL ESTATE PROFESSIONALS TO FACILITATE THE SALE OF REAL
18 PROPERTY, INCLUDING USE IN THE PREPARATION OF MARKET EVALUATIONS AND
19 APPRAISALS.

20 (B) WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE SALE OF A NEW HOME IN THE STATE, A
21 DEVELOPER, BUILDER, BROKER, OR REAL ESTATE AGENT SHALL ENTER THE FINAL

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
4 October 1, 2026.
