CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Real Property – Short-Term Rentals**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the governing body of a county or municipality from
4 enacting a local law or ordinance prohibiting the offering of certain residential
5 property as a short-term rental by an operator solely because the operator is a lessee
6 or sublessee of the property; authorizing the governing body of a county or
7 municipality to enact a local law or ordinance prohibiting the operator of a
8 short-term rental who is a lessee or sublessee of the property from operating more
9 than one short-term rental within the county or municipality; and generally relating
10 to short-term rental property.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Real Property**

19 **14-126.1.**

1 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
2 INDICATED.

3 (2) “OPERATOR” MEANS THE PROPRIETOR OF ANY DWELLING,
4 LODGING, OR SLEEPING ACCOMMODATIONS OFFERED AS A SHORT-TERM RENTAL,
5 WHETHER IN THE CAPACITY OF OWNER, LESSEE, SUBLESSEE, MORTGAGEE IN
6 POSSESSION, LICENSEE, OR ANY OTHER POSSESSORY CAPACITY.

7 (3) (I) “SHORT-TERM RENTAL” MEANS A RESIDENTIAL DWELLING
8 UNIT OR A PORTION OF THE UNIT, INCLUDING AN ACCESSORY DWELLING, USED TO
9 PROVIDE HOUSING FOR LESS THAN 31 CONSECUTIVE DAYS.

10 (II) “SHORT-TERM RENTAL” DOES NOT INCLUDE A HOTEL OR
11 MOTEL, BOARDING HOUSE, GROUP RESIDENTIAL FACILITY FOR STUDENTS,
12 FRATERNITY OR SORORITY HOUSE, OR SIMILAR HOUSING.

13 (B) (1) THE GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY MAY NOT
14 ENACT A LOCAL LAW OR ORDINANCE PROHIBITING AN OPERATOR FROM OFFERING
15 A PROPERTY AS A SHORT-TERM RENTAL SOLELY BECAUSE THE OPERATOR IS A
16 LESSEE OR SUBLESSEE OF THE PROPERTY.

17 (2) THE GOVERNING BODY OF A COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY MAY
18 ENACT A LOCAL LAW OR ORDINANCE PROHIBITING AN OPERATOR FROM OPERATING
19 MORE THAN ONE PROPERTY IN THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPALITY AS A SHORT-TERM
20 RENTAL IF THE OPERATOR IS A LESSEE OR SUBLESSEE OF THE PROPERTY.

21 (C) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION MAY BE INTERPRETED AS PROHIBITING ~~A~~;

22 (1) A PROPERTY OWNER FROM PROHIBITING OR LIMITING THE USE
23 OF THE PROPERTY BY A LESSEE OR SUBLESSEE AS A SHORT-TERM RENTAL; OR

24 (2) A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT FROM REQUIRING AN
25 OPERATOR TO REGISTER A SHORT-TERM RENTAL.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
27 October 1, 2026.
