2 **Public Schools – School Mapping Data – Radius of School Grounds**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the school mapping data produced with funding from the
4 School Mapping Data Program to contain certain labeling that matches a certain
5 radius surrounding the school grounds; and generally relating to school mapping
6 data.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Education**

15 7–1510.1.

16 (d) (4) At a minimum, school mapping data produced with funding from the
17 Program shall:

1 (i) Be compatible with software platforms used by the school and
2 local, State, and federal public safety agencies that provide emergency services to the school
3 without requiring the purchase of additional software or charging a fee to view or access
4 the data;

5 (ii) Be in a printable format and, if requested, be in a digital file
6 format that can be integrated into interactive mobile platforms;

7 (iii) Be verified for accuracy by a walk-through of the school
8 buildings and grounds;

9 (iv) Be oriented true north;

10 (v) Be overlaid on current aerial imagery;

11 (vi) Contain site-specific labeling that matches the structure of
12 school buildings, including:

13 1. Room labels;

14 2. Hallway names;

15 3. External door or stairwell numbers; and

16 4. Locations of:

17 A. Hazards;

18 B. Critical utility locations;

19 C. Key boxes; and

20 D. Automated external defibrillators and trauma kits;

21 (vii) Contain site-specific labeling that matches the school grounds,
22 including:

23 1. Parking areas;

24 2. Athletic fields;

25 3. Surrounding roads; and

26 4. Neighboring properties; [and]

1 **(VIII) ~~CONTAIN~~ BEGINNING JULY 1, 2026, CONTAIN**
2 **SITE-SPECIFIC LABELING ~~THAT MATCHES~~ FOR BODIES OF WATER IN THE 1-MILE**
3 **RADIUS SURROUNDING THE SCHOOL GROUNDS, ~~INCLUDING BODIES OF WATER;~~ AND**

4 **[(viii)] (IX)** Be overlaid with gridded x and y coordinates.

6 1, 2026.
