16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That Section(s) 7–417 through 7–421 of Article – General Provisions of the Annotated Code
18 of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 7–418 through 7–422, respectively.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read

2 **THE GOVERNOR ANNUALLY SHALL PROCLAIM OCTOBER 1 AS PURPLE**
3 **LIGHTS NIGHT TO HONOR THE INDIVIDUALS IN THE STATE WHO ARE VICTIMS OR**
4 **SURVIVORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND EXPRESS SUPPORT FOR THE ELIMINATION**
5 **OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE IN THE STATE.**

6 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
7 1, 2026.
