11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 14–102.

3 (g) (1) In the event a qualified volunteer who has completed 25 years of  
4 certified service dies, a death **OR BURIAL** benefit up to [~~\$10,000~~] **\$14,000** shall be payable.

5 (2) In the event a volunteer who is receiving benefits under Subsection (h)  
6 of this section dies, a **DEATH OR** burial benefit up to [~~\$336~~] **\$560** for each year of certified  
7 service shall be payable.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
9 1, 2026.
