## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Civil Actions – Nonprofit Organizations – Unauthorized Support of Israeli**  
3 **Settlement Activity**  
4 **(Not On Our Dime Act)**

5 FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain nonprofit organizations from aiding or abetting  
6 certain activity by the government of Israel or a citizen of Israel; authorizing the  
7 Attorney General or a certain person to bring a certain action against a nonprofit  
8 organization that violates this Act; requiring the Secretary of State to remove a  
9 nonprofit organization from the Registry of Charitable Solicitation following receipt  
10 of certain notice; and generally relating to the prohibition against unauthorized  
11 support of Israeli settlement activity by a nonprofit organization.

12 BY adding to  
13 Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings  
14 Section 3–2701 and 3–2702 to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 27. Nonprofit  
15 Organizations – Unauthorized Support of Israeli Settlement Activity”  
16 Annotated Code of Maryland  
17 (2020 Replacement Volume and 2025 Supplement)

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

21 **SUBTITLE 27. NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS – UNAUTHORIZED SUPPORT OF**  
22 **ISRAELI SETTLEMENT ACTIVITY.**

24 **(A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS**

2 (B) “NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION” MEANS AN ORGANIZATION EXEMPT FROM  
3 TAXATION UNDER § 501(C)(3) OR (4) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.

4 (C) “OCCUPIED TERRITORY” MEANS THE ISRAELI–OCCUPIED WEST BANK,  
5 INCLUDING EAST JERUSALEM.

6 (D) (1) “PROTECTED PERSONS” MEANS INDIVIDUALS PROTECTED  
7 UNDER GENEVA CONVENTION (IV) RELATIVE TO THE PROTECTION OF CIVILIAN  
8 PERSONS IN TIME OF WAR, 12 AUGUST 1949, 6 U.S.T. 3516.

9 (2) “PROTECTED PERSONS” INCLUDES CIVILIANS IN OCCUPIED  
10 TERRITORY IN ACCORDANCE WITH INTERNATIONAL LAW.

11 (E) “UNAUTHORIZED SUPPORT OF ISRAELI SETTLEMENT ACTIVITY” MEANS  
12 AIDING AND ABETTING ACTIVITY OF THE GOVERNMENT OF ISRAEL, OR A CITIZEN OF  
13 ISRAEL, THAT IS BANNED UNDER THE GENEVA CONVENTIONS SIGNED AUGUST 12,  
14 1949, AS AMENDED, AND THEIR ADDITIONAL PROTOCOLS, TO WHICH THE UNITED  
15 STATES IS A PARTY, INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITY:

16 (1) THE UNLAWFUL TRANSFER OF ISRAELI CIVILIANS INTO  
17 OCCUPIED TERRITORY;

18 (2) ACTS OF VIOLENCE AGAINST PROTECTED PERSONS BY CITIZENS  
19 OF ISRAEL LIVING IN OCCUPIED TERRITORIES, INCLUDING:

20 (I) ABDUCTION;

21 (II) MURDER;

22 (III) ASSAULT;

23 (IV) ARSON; AND

24 (V) THE COMMISSION OF ANY ACT DESCRIBED IN ITEMS (I)  
25 THROUGH (IV) OF THIS ITEM USING A FIREARM OR EXPLOSIVE DEVICE;

26 (3) CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY INCLUDING:

27 (I) THE KILLING OR HARMING OF ANIMALS AND LIVESTOCK;

28 (II) THE DESTRUCTION OF TREES AND CROPS;

1 (III) THE APPROPRIATION, EXPROPRIATION, SEIZURE,  
2 DESTRUCTION, DEMOLITION, DISMANTLEMENT, OR CONFISCATION, IN WHOLE OR IN  
3 PART, OF PRIVATE PROPERTY, INCLUDING:

- 4 1. HOMES;
- 5 2. APARTMENT BUILDINGS;
- 6 3. COMMERCIAL PROPERTY;
- 7 4. FOOD MARKETS; AND
- 8 5. ANIMAL SHELTERS; AND

9 (IV) BLOCKING ACCESS TO PALESTINIAN LANDS BY FENCING,  
10 STRUCTURES, OR OTHER MEANS;

11 (4) THE UNILATERAL ACQUISITION AND ANNEXATION OF LAND IN  
12 OCCUPIED TERRITORY;

13 (5) THE FORCED TRANSFER OR EVICTION OF PROTECTED PERSONS  
14 WITHIN OCCUPIED TERRITORY, OR THE DEPORTATION OF PROTECTED PERSONS  
15 FROM OCCUPIED TERRITORY; AND

16 (6) THE DESTRUCTION OF INFRASTRUCTURE WITHIN OCCUPIED  
17 TERRITORY INCLUDING THE DESTRUCTION OF:

- 18 (I) HOSPITALS AND OTHER MEDICAL FACILITIES;
- 19 (II) WATER AND SEWAGE SYSTEM ELEMENTS;
- 20 (III) ELECTRICAL LINES;
- 21 (IV) ROADS;
- 22 (V) SCHOOLS; AND
- 23 (VI) NETWORK FACILITIES.

25 (A) A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION REGISTERED WITH THE SECRETARY OF

1 STATE TO SOLICIT CHARITABLE DONATIONS IN THE STATE MAY NOT KNOWINGLY  
2 ENGAGE IN UNAUTHORIZED SUPPORT OF ISRAELI SETTLEMENT ACTIVITY.

3 (B) (1) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY BRING AN ACTION FOR  
4 INJUNCTIVE RELIEF AND DAMAGES ON BEHALF OF THE STATE OR ANY OF ITS  
5 POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS AGAINST A DIRECTOR, AN OFFICER, A PARTNER, A  
6 TRUSTEE, A MANAGER, OR ANY OTHER AGENT OF A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT  
7 VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

8 (2) IN AN ACTION FILED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS  
9 SUBSECTION, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY SEEK NOT LESS THAN \$1,000,000 IN  
10 DAMAGES.

11 (C) (1) A PERSON HARMED BY A VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS  
12 SECTION MAY BRING AN ACTION FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF AND ACTUAL DAMAGES  
13 AGAINST A DIRECTOR, AN OFFICER, A PARTNER, A TRUSTEE, A MANAGER, OR ANY  
14 OTHER AGENT OF A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF  
15 THIS SECTION.

16 (2) IN ADDITION TO INJUNCTIVE RELIEF AND ACTUAL DAMAGES, A  
17 COURT MAY AWARD ATTORNEY'S FEES TO A PREVAILING PLAINTIFF.

18 (D) ON NOTICE FROM THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OR A PREVAILING  
19 PLAINTIFF OF A JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION  
20 UNDER THIS SECTION, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL REMOVE THE NONPROFIT  
21 ORGANIZATION FROM THE REGISTRY OF CHARITABLE SOLICITATION.

22 (E) AN ACTION UNDER THIS SECTION:

23 (1) MAY BE BROUGHT IN ANY COUNTY IN THE STATE; AND

24 (2) SHALL BE FILED WITHIN 10 YEARS AFTER THE DATE OF THE  
25 OCCURRENCE OF THE ACT ON WHICH THE CLAIM IS BASED.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
27 October 1, 2026.
