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## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Illegal Online Gambling Enforcement Act**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting certain persons from knowingly operating, offering,  
4 conducting, engaging in, or promoting illegal online gambling in the State;  
5 prohibiting certain persons from knowingly supporting, directly or indirectly, the  
6 operation, conduct, or promotion of illegal online gambling in the State; authorizing  
7 the Attorney General and certain prosecuting attorneys to take certain actions, issue  
8 certain orders, and seek certain relief in order to enforce this Act; making a violation  
9 of this Act an unfair, abusive, or deceptive trade practice under the Maryland  
10 Consumer Protection Act; and generally relating to illegal online gambling.

27 (C) **“DIVISION” MEANS THE DIVISION OF CONSUMER PROTECTION OF THE**  
28 **OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.**

29 (D) **“FINANCIAL TRANSACTION PROVIDER” MEANS ANY PERSON THAT**  
30 **FACILITATES OR PARTICIPATES IN ANY FINANCIAL TRANSACTION BETWEEN AN**

1 ONLINE GAMBLING PLAYER AND AN ONLINE GAMBLING OPERATOR, INCLUDING A  
2 PAYMENT PROCESSOR, CREDIT CARD ISSUER, FINANCIAL INSTITUTION, MONEY  
3 TRANSMITTING BUSINESS, OR PAYMENT NETWORK UTILIZED TO EFFECT A CREDIT  
4 CARD TRANSACTION, A DEBIT CARD TRANSACTION, AN ELECTRONIC FUND  
5 TRANSFER OR A MONEY TRANSMITTING SERVICE, OR ANY OTHER PARTICIPANT IN A  
6 DESIGNATED PAYMENT SYSTEM.

7 (E) "ILLEGAL" MEANS NOT EXPRESSLY AUTHORIZED BY APPLICABLE LAW.

8 (F) "ONLINE GAMBLING" MEANS THE BUSINESS OF OFFERING OR  
9 ACCEPTING WAGERS, THROUGH AN ONLINE GAMING SYSTEM ON A COMPUTER,  
10 MOBILE DEVICE, TABLET, OR ANY OTHER INTERACTIVE DEVICE, ON ANY GAME,  
11 CONTEST, LOTTERY, PROMOTION, OR CONTRIVANCE THEREOF, INCLUDING TABLE  
12 GAMES, SLOT MACHINES, VIDEO POKER, SWEEPSTAKES GAMES, GAMES OF CHANCE,  
13 AND ANY OTHER GAME TYPICALLY OFFERED IN A CASINO.

14 (G) (1) "ONLINE GAMBLING OPERATOR" MEANS A PERSON WHO OWNS,  
15 MAINTAINS, OR OPERATES AN INTERNET WEBSITE THAT IS USED FOR ILLEGAL  
16 ONLINE GAMBLING.

17 (2) "ONLINE GAMBLING OPERATOR" DOES NOT INCLUDE A PERSON  
18 LICENSED TO CONDUCT ONLINE SPORTS WAGERING OR FANTASY COMPETITIONS  
19 UNDER SUBTITLES 1D AND 1E OF THIS TITLE.

20 (H) "PLATFORM PROVIDER" MEANS ANY PERSON THAT:

21 (1) STORES OR HOSTS CONTENT, FILES, DATA, AND OTHER  
22 INFORMATION ON A WEB SERVER; AND

23 (2) MAKES THE CONTENT, FILES, DATA, OR OTHER INFORMATION  
24 ACCESSIBLE ON AN INTERNET WEBSITE VIA A COMPUTER, MOBILE DEVICE, TABLET,  
25 OR OTHER INTERACTIVE DEVICE.

26 (I) "SWEEPSTAKES GAMES" MEANS A GAME, CONTEST, OR PROMOTION  
27 THAT:

28 (1) UTILIZES A DUAL-CURRENCY SYSTEM OF PAYMENT ALLOWING  
29 THE PLAYER TO EXCHANGE THE CURRENCY FOR ANY PRIZE, AWARD, CASH OR CASH  
30 EQUIVALENTS, OR CHANCE TO WIN ANY PRIZE, AWARD, CASH OR CASH  
31 EQUIVALENTS; AND

32 (2) SIMULATES ANY FORM OF GAMBLING, INCLUDING:

1 (I) CASINO–STYLE GAMES, INCLUDING SLOT MACHINES, VIDEO  
2 POKER, AND TABLE GAMES SUCH AS BLACKJACK, ROULETTE, CRAPS, AND POKER;

3 (II) LOTTERY GAMES INCLUDING DRAW GAMES, INSTANT WIN  
4 GAMES, KENO, AND BINGO; AND

5 (III) SPORTS WAGERING.

6 (J) “WAGER” MEANS THE PROVISION OF CONSIDERATION, INCLUDING  
7 MONEY OR ANYTHING OF VALUE, IN EXCHANGE FOR THE OPPORTUNITY TO PLAY ANY  
8 GAME, CONTEST, LOTTERY, OR CONTRIVANCE AND RECEIVE MONEY OR SOMETHING  
9 OF VALUE IN THE EVENT OF A CERTAIN OUTCOME, WHICH OUTCOME IS DETERMINED  
10 BY SKILL, CHANCE, OR ELEMENTS OF SKILL AND CHANCE.

27 (I) SPECIFY THE ILLEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING ACTIVITY;

28 (II) STATE THAT THE PERSON HAS 10 DAYS AFTER THE DATE ON  
29 WHICH THE ORDER IS RECEIVED TO BLOCK THE ABILITY OF INDIVIDUALS

1 PHYSICALLY LOCATED IN THE STATE TO ACCESS THE ILLEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING  
2 ACTIVITY; AND

3 (III) STATE THAT FAILURE TO BLOCK ACCESS TO THE ILLEGAL  
4 ONLINE GAMBLING ACTIVITY WITHIN 10 DAYS MAY RESULT IN IMPRISONMENT OR A  
5 FINE OR BOTH, AS PROVIDED UNDER § 9-1F-06(A)(1) OF THIS SUBTITLE.

6 (B) (1) A PROSECUTING ATTORNEY WHO IS NOT THE ATTORNEY  
7 GENERAL WHO ISSUES A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS  
8 SECTION SHALL FORWARD A COPY OF THE ORDER TO THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

9 (2) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL MAINTAIN:

10 (I) A DEPOSITORY TO COLLECT, MAINTAIN, AND RETAIN EACH  
11 CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION; AND

12 (II) A LIST, PUBLICLY AVAILABLE ON THE OFFICE OF THE  
13 ATTORNEY GENERAL'S INTERNET WEBSITE, THAT IDENTIFIES THE NAME OF EACH  
14 ONLINE GAMBLING OPERATOR AND THE ASSOCIATED ONLINE GAMBLING INTERNET  
15 WEBSITE URL ADDRESS THAT HAS BEEN ISSUED A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER.

16 (3) THE FAILURE OF A PROSECUTING ATTORNEY OR THE ATTORNEY  
17 GENERAL TO COMPLY WITH THIS SUBSECTION IS NOT A DEFENSE TO ANY ACTION  
18 COMMENCED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

19 (C) (1) A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ISSUED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF  
20 THIS SECTION SHALL BE SERVED:

21 (I) IN COMPLIANCE WITH MARYLAND RULES 2-121 AND 2-124;  
22 OR

23 (II) BY PUBLICATION IN COMPLIANCE WITH MARYLAND RULE  
24 2-122(A)(2).

25 (2) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL IS NOT REQUIRED TO MAKE  
26 REASONABLE EFFORTS TO LOCATE THE ONLINE GAMBLING OPERATOR BEFORE  
27 SERVING THE CEASE AND DESIST ORDER BY PUBLICATION.

28 (D) A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER SERVED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS  
29 SECTION:

30 (1) IS ADMISSIBLE IN ANY PROCEEDING UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; AND

1           **(2) CONSTITUTES PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE THAT THE PERSON HAS**  
2 **KNOWLEDGE THAT ILLEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING WAS OCCURRING ON THE ONLINE**  
3 **GAMBLING OPERATOR’S INTERNET WEBSITE.**

4           **(E) A PERSON OUTSIDE THE STATE WHO OWNS, MAINTAINS, OR OPERATES**  
5 **AN INTERNET WEBSITE THAT TRANSMITS INFORMATION THROUGH OR WITH A**  
6 **PLATFORM PROVIDER AND WHO KNOWS OR SHOULD HAVE KNOWN THAT THE**  
7 **INFORMATION IS BROADCAST WITHIN THE STATE SUBMITS TO THE JURISDICTION**  
8 **OF STATE COURTS FOR ENFORCEMENT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.**

9           **(F) BEFORE ISSUING A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER UNDER SUBSECTION (A)**  
10 **OF THIS SECTION, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL MAY PROVIDE REASONABLE NOTICE TO**  
11 **THE COMMISSION TO ALLOW THE COMMISSION TO DETERMINE WHETHER IT WILL**  
12 **JOIN THE ORDER.**

24 **YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$50,000 OR BOTH; AND**

25                   **(II) FOR EACH SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION, IMPRISONMENT NOT**  
26 **EXCEEDING 3 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$100,000 OR BOTH.**

27           **(2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES § 9-1F-03(2) OF THIS SUBTITLE IS**

29                   **(I) FOR A FIRST VIOLATION, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$25,000;**

1           **(B) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION:**

2                   **(1) EACH ONLINE GAMBLING WAGER OFFERED OR ACCEPTED BY A**  
3 **PERSON CONSTITUTES A SEPARATE VIOLATION; AND**

4                   **(2) EACH INDIVIDUAL PROMOTION OF ILLEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING IN**  
5 **THE STATE CONSTITUTES A SEPARATE VIOLATION.**

6           **(C) A COURT SHALL ORDER THE FORFEITURE OF ANY PROFITS, GAINS,**  
7 **GROSS RECEIPTS, OR OTHER BENEFITS EARNED BY A PERSON IN CONNECTION WITH**  
8 **A VIOLATION OF THIS SUBTITLE.**

9           **(D) THE COMMISSION SHALL REVOKE A GAMING LICENSE ISSUED UNDER**  
10 **THIS TITLE HELD BY A PERSON FOUND TO HAVE VIOLATED § 9-1F-03 OF THIS**  
11 **SUBTITLE, AND THE PERSON IS INELIGIBLE IN THE FUTURE TO HOLD A GAMING**  
12 **LICENSE ISSUED BY THE COMMISSION.**

19 **IDENTIFIED BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 9-1F-04 OF THIS**  
20 **SUBTITLE ARE ENGAGED IN ILLEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING.**

22           **(A) (1) A PLATFORM PROVIDER MAY NOT RECEIVE OR TRANSMIT**  
23 **THROUGH ITS SERVICE ANY EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION THAT IT REASONABLY**  
24 **BELIEVES IS OR WILL BE SENT IN CONNECTION WITH THE PARTICIPATION OF A**  
25 **PERSON IN ILLEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING.**

26                   **(2) A PLATFORM PROVIDER IS DEEMED TO HAVE CONSTRUCTIVE**  
27 **KNOWLEDGE THAT ALL PERSONS AND WEBSITE URLS IDENTIFIED BY THE**  
28 **ATTORNEY GENERAL IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 9-1F-04 OF THIS SUBTITLE ARE**  
29 **ENGAGED IN ILLEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING.**

30           **(B) BEFORE HOSTING, FACILITATING, OR TRANSMITTING ANY ONLINE**  
31 **GAMBLING ADVERTISEMENT ON A WEBSITE, A PLATFORM PROVIDER SHALL:**

1 (1) OBTAIN A CERTIFIED COPY OF THE ONLINE GAMBLING  
2 OPERATOR'S LICENSE OR PERMIT TO OFFER ONLINE GAMBLING IN THE STATE; OR

3 (2) OBTAIN WRITTEN CONFIRMATION FROM THE COMMISSION THAT  
4 THE OPERATOR IS LICENSED OR PERMITTED TO OFFER ONLINE GAMBLING IN THE  
5 STATE.

19 INTERNET WEBSITE CONDUCTING OR OFFERING ILLEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING TO  
20 PERSONS PHYSICALLY LOCATED IN THE STATE.

21 (II) THE CEASE AND DESIST ORDER SHALL:

22 1. IDENTIFY THE ONLINE GAMBLING INTERNET  
23 WEBSITE URL THAT THE PLATFORM PROVIDER MUST DISABLE AND FOR WHICH IT  
24 MUST BLOCK THE RECEIPT OR TRANSMISSION OF ANY EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION  
25 THROUGH ITS SERVICE;

26 2. STATE THAT THE PLATFORM PROVIDER HAS 30 DAYS  
27 AFTER THE DATE ON WHICH THE ORDER IS RECEIVED TO DISABLE THE ONLINE  
28 GAMBLING WEBSITE FROM ACCESS BY INDIVIDUALS PHYSICALLY LOCATED IN THE  
29 STATE AND BLOCK THE RECEIPT OR TRANSMISSION OF INFORMATION THROUGH ITS  
30 SERVICE AS REQUIRED IN THE ORDER; AND

31 3. STATE THAT FAILURE TO DISABLE THE ONLINE  
32 GAMBLING INTERNET WEBSITE FROM ACCESS BY PERSONS PHYSICALLY LOCATED  
33 IN THE STATE AND BLOCK THE RECEIPT OR TRANSMISSION OF INFORMATION

1 THROUGH ITS SERVICE WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING THE ORDER MAY RESULT  
2 IN A FINE UNDER § 9-1F-06(A)(2) OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR EACH DAY THAT THE  
3 ONLINE GAMBLING INTERNET WEBSITE URL IS NOT DISABLED TO PERSONS  
4 PHYSICALLY LOCATED IN THE STATE AND FOR EACH RECEIPT OR TRANSMISSION OF  
5 INFORMATION THROUGH ITS SERVICE AS REQUIRED IN THE ORDER.

6 (III) A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ISSUED UNDER THIS  
7 PARAGRAPH MAY BE SERVED ON A PLATFORM PROVIDER BY REGISTERED MAIL OR  
8 FIRST-CLASS MAIL AT ANY ADDRESS REGISTERED WITH THE STATE FOR THE  
9 PLATFORM PROVIDER OR AT WHICH THE PLATFORM PROVIDER CONDUCTS  
10 BUSINESS.

11 (IV) A PLATFORM PROVIDER SHALL TIMELY COMPLY WITH A  
12 CEASE AND DESIST ORDER SERVED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS PARAGRAPH.

13 (V) A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER SERVED UNDER THIS  
14 PARAGRAPH:

15 1. IS ADMISSIBLE IN ANY PROCEEDING UNDER THIS  
16 SUBTITLE; AND

23 INFORMATION OVER THE INTERNET TO OR FROM PERSONS PHYSICALLY LOCATED  
24 IN THE STATE SUBMITS TO THE JURISDICTION OF STATE COURTS FOR  
25 ENFORCEMENT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

26 (B) (1) A FINANCIAL TRANSACTION PROVIDER MAY, ON ITS OWN  
27 INITIATIVE, BLOCK, PROHIBIT, PREVENT, OR OTHERWISE REFUSE TO HONOR ANY  
28 FINANCIAL TRANSACTION THAT IT REASONABLY BELIEVES IS OR WILL BE IN  
29 VIOLATION OF § 9-1F-07 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

30 (2) A FINANCIAL TRANSACTION PROVIDER MAY NOT BE HELD LIABLE  
31 IN TORT TO ANY PERSON FOR TAKING THE ACTIONS AUTHORIZED UNDER  
32 PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

33 (C) (1) THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, ACTING THROUGH  
34 THE DIVISION, OR A PROSECUTING ATTORNEY MAY ISSUE A WRITTEN CEASE AND

9 THAT THE PERSON MUST CEASE, BLOCK, DISCONTINUE, AND PREVENT ANY SUPPORT  
10 OF WITH RESPECT TO ACTIVITIES INVOLVING ONLINE GAMBLING WITHIN THE  
11 STATE;

12 (II) STATE THAT THE PERSON HAS 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE ON  
13 WHICH THE ORDER IS RECEIVED TO IMPLEMENT THE DIRECTIVES IN THE ORDER;  
14 AND

15 (III) STATE THAT FAILURE TO IMPLEMENT THE DIRECTIVES SET  
16 FORTH IN THE ORDER WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER RECEIVING THE ORDER MAY RESULT  
17 IN A FINE UNDER § 9-1F-06(A)(2) OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR EACH ACT OF SUPPORT IN  
18 RELATION TO THE ONLINE GAMBLING INTERNET WEBSITE URL IDENTIFIED IN THE  
19 ORDER INVOLVING A PERSON PHYSICALLY LOCATED IN THE STATE.

20 (3) A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION  
21 MAY BE SERVED ON THE PERSON BY REGISTERED MAIL OR FIRST-CLASS MAIL AT  
22 ANY ADDRESS REGISTERED WITH THE STATE FOR THE PERSON OR AT WHICH THE  
23 PERSON CONDUCTS BUSINESS.

24 (4) A PERSON SHALL COMPLY TIMELY WITH A CEASE AND DESIST  
25 ORDER SERVED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SUBSECTION.

26 (5) A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER UNDER THIS SUBSECTION:

27 (I) IS ADMISSIBLE IN ANY PROCEEDING UNDER THIS SUBTITLE;  
28 AND

29 (II) CONSTITUTES PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE THAT THE PERSON  
30 HAS KNOWLEDGE THAT ILLEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING WAS OCCURRING ON THE  
31 ONLINE GAMBLING INTERNET WEBSITE URL IDENTIFIED IN THE ORDER.

32 (6) A PERSON WHOSE PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS IS OUTSIDE  
33 THE STATE THAT SUPPORTS ONLINE GAMBLING WITHIN OR INVOLVING ANY PERSON

1 PHYSICALLY LOCATED IN THE STATE SUBMITS TO THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE  
2 COURTS FOR ENFORCEMENT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

3 (D) THE CHAIR OF THE COMMISSION MAY CONSULT WITH THE ATTORNEY  
4 GENERAL ON THE ISSUANCE OF CEASE AND DESIST ORDERS UNDER SUBSECTIONS  
5 (A)(3) AND (C) OF THIS SECTION.

7 (A) (1) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER REMEDY UNDER CURRENT LAW, ON  
8 APPLICATION BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OR A PROSECUTING ATTORNEY AND  
9 REGARDLESS OF WHETHER PROCEEDINGS HAVE BEEN INITIATED UNDER THIS  
10 SUBTITLE, A COURT MAY ISSUE ANY RELIEF THAT IT DEEMS APPROPRIATE TO  
11 PREVENT AND RESTRAIN ACTIVITIES PROHIBITED BY THIS SUBTITLE.

12 (2) THE RELIEF MAY INCLUDE A TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER, A  
13 PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION, OR AN INJUNCTION AGAINST ANY PERSON TO PREVENT  
14 OR RESTRAIN ILLEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING AND ANY RELATED TRANSACTIONS OR  
15 ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING THE REMOVAL OF ANY ILLEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING  
16 INTERNET WEBSITE, THE FREEZING OF BANK OR CREDIT ACCOUNTS ASSOCIATED  
17 WITH THE INTERNET WEBSITE OR THE ILLEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING ACTIVITY, AND  
18 THE REMOVAL OF A PERSON'S ACCESS TO SUCH INTERNET WEBSITES OR ACCOUNTS  
19 BY A PERSON WHO PARTICIPATES IN THE ILLEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING ACTIVITY.

20 (3) IN AN ACTION SEEKING INJUNCTIVE RELIEF, A VIOLATION OF  
21 THIS SUBTITLE IS CONCLUSIVELY DETERMINED TO BE AN IRREPARABLE HARM.

22 (B) (1) IN ADDITION TO THE REMEDIES AVAILABLE UNDER SUBSECTION  
23 (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OR A PROSECUTING ATTORNEY MAY  
24 SEEK AN EX PARTE INJUNCTION TO:

25 (I) COMPEL A PLATFORM PROVIDER TO REMOVE OR DISABLE  
26 ACCESS TO AN INTERNET WEBSITE VIOLATING THIS SUBTITLE OR A HYPERTEXT  
27 LINK TO A WEBSITE VIOLATING THIS SUBTITLE;

28 (II) ENJOIN A FINANCIAL TRANSACTION PROVIDER FROM  
29 PROCESSING TRANSACTIONS FOR THE ILLEGAL ONLINE GAMBLING OPERATOR; AND

30 (III) COMPEL A PERSON TO DISCONTINUE SUPPORTING ILLEGAL  
31 ONLINE GAMBLING IN THE STATE.

1           **(2) A HEARING ON THE EX PARTE INJUNCTION MUST BE HELD WITHIN**  
2 **30 DAYS AFTER IT IS FILED, AND AFTER THE HEARING THE COURT MAY CONVERT**
