A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Community Colleges – Collective Bargaining – Definition of Supervisory**
3 **Employee**

4 FOR the purpose of defining the term “supervisory employee” for purposes of collective
5 bargaining in community colleges; and generally relating to collective bargaining.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

8 Section 16–701(a), (j), and (o)

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Education**

19 16–701.

20 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

21 (j) (1) “Faculty” means employees whose assignments involve academic
22 responsibilities, including teachers and department heads.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 (2) “Faculty” does not include officers, supervisory employees, confidential
2 employees, part–time faculty, or student assistants.

3 (o) (1) “Public employee” means an employee employed by a public employer.

4 (2) “Public employee” includes faculty and part–time faculty at the
5 Baltimore City Community College.

6 (3) “Public employee” does not include:

7 (i) Officers;

8 (ii) Supervisory or confidential employees; or

9 (iii) Student assistants.

10 **(q) (1) “SUPERVISORY EMPLOYEE” MEANS AN EMPLOYEE WHO HAS**
11 **AUTHORITY TO:**

12 **(I) HIRE, TRANSFER, SUSPEND, LAY OFF, RECALL, PROMOTE,**
13 **DISCHARGE, ASSIGN, REWARD, OR DISCIPLINE EMPLOYEES;**

14 **(II) RESPONSIBLY DIRECT EMPLOYEES FOR MORE THAN 50%**
15 **OF THE EMPLOYEE’S WORKING HOURS; AND**

16 **(III) ADDRESS AND RESOLVE EMPLOYEE COMPLAINTS.**

17 **(2) “SUPERVISORY EMPLOYEE” DOES NOT INCLUDE A DEPARTMENT**
18 **HEAD OR AN EMPLOYEE IN A COMPARABLE POSITION OR ANY FACULTY MEMBER**
19 **BELOW THE LEVEL OF ASSISTANT DEAN.**

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
21 1, 2026.
