1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Athletic Commission – Blood Testing of Contestants – Timing**

3 FOR the purpose of extending the period of time before applying for a license to participate
4 in a boxing, kick boxing, wrestling, or mixed martial arts contest and before
5 participating in the contest during which certain blood testing may be conducted for
6 purposes of submission of the results to the State Athletic Commission; and
7 generally relating to the State Athletic Commission and required blood testing of
8 contestants.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (a) In this title the following words have the meanings indicated.

4 (c) “Commission” means the State Athletic Commission.

5 (d) (1) “Contest” means a boxing, kick boxing, or wrestling:

6 (i) competition;

7 (ii) exhibition;

8 (iii) match;

9 (iv) performance; or

10 (v) show.

11 (2) “Contest” includes a mixed martial arts:

12 (i) competition;

13 (ii) match;

14 (iii) performance; or

15 (iv) show.

16 (3) “Contest” does not include a mixed martial arts exhibition.

17 (e) “Contestant” means an individual who participates in a boxing, professional
18 kick boxing, amateur kick boxing, professional mixed martial arts, or amateur mixed
19 martial arts contest.

20 4–304.1.

21 (a) Each applicant for a license to participate as a contestant in a contest shall
22 present documentary evidence, satisfactory to the Commission, that:23 (1) within the prior [30–day] **90–DAY** period, the applicant has been tested
24 for the presence of:

25 (i) antibodies to the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV);

1 (ii) the antigen of virus hepatitis B; and

2 (iii) antibodies to virus hepatitis C; and

3 (2) the results of all tests are negative.

4 (b) Whenever directed by the Commission, an individual who is licensed to
5 participate as a contestant in a contest shall present documentary evidence, satisfactory to
6 the Commission, that:

7 (1) within [30] **90** days prior to participating in a contest, the individual
8 has been tested for the presence of:

9 (i) antibodies to the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV);

10 (ii) the antigen of virus hepatitis B; and

11 (iii) antibodies to virus hepatitis C; and

12 (2) the results of all tests are negative.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2026.
