2 **State Board of Elections – Address Confidentiality Program – Designation of**
3 **Contact Person**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Board of Elections to designate a contact person for
5 the Address Confidentiality Program; and generally relating to the State Board of
6 Elections and the Address Confidentiality Program.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – State Government**

2 The Secretary of State shall establish and administer an Address Confidentiality
3 Program for survivors of threatened, attempted, or actual domestic violence, sexual assault,
4 stalking, harassment, or human trafficking.

5 7-309.

6 (a) (1) Each local board of elections shall use a Program participant's actual
7 address for all election-related purposes, **INCLUDING ABSENTEE BALLOTS.**

8 (2) A Program participant may not use the substitute address designated
9 by the Secretary of State as the Program participant's address for voter registration
10 purposes.

11 (b) A local board of elections may not make a Program participant's address
12 contained in voter registration records available for public inspection or copying except:

13 (1) on request by a law enforcement agency for law enforcement purposes;
14 and

15 (2) as directed by a court order to disclose the address.

16 (c) (1) **THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS SHALL DESIGNATE A CONTACT**
17 **PERSON FOR THE PROGRAM.**

18 (2) **THE CONTACT PERSON SHALL ACT AS CONTACT FOR INQUIRIES**
19 **ABOUT THE PROGRAM FROM LOCAL BOARDS OF ELECTIONS AND PROGRAM**
20 **PARTICIPANTS ON MATTERS RELATED TO IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SECTION.**

21 (d) **THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY**
22 **OUT THIS SECTION.**

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
24 1, 2026.
