## 1 AN ACT concerning

## Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission – Membership – Alterations

4 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Baltimore County School Board  
5 Nominating Commission to include one representative of the Greater Baltimore  
6 County Chamber of Commerce, one representative of the American Federation of  
7 State, County and Municipal Employees Local 3, Council 434, and one representative  
8 of the Citizens Advisory Council for Gifted and Talented Education; and generally  
9 relating to the Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

21 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 Article – Education

23 3-2B-03.

24 (a) (1) There is a Baltimore County School Board Nominating Commission.

5 (3) The Governor, in consultation with the County Executive of Baltimore  
6 County, shall appoint eight members, one from each legislative district that lies in whole  
7 or in part in Baltimore County.

10 (5) The following organizations each shall appoint one member:

11 (i) The Teachers Association of Baltimore County;

12 (ii) The GREATER Baltimore County Chamber of Commerce;

13 (iii) The PTA Council of Baltimore County, Inc.;

14 (iv) Towson University;

15 (v) The League of Women Voters of Baltimore County;

16 (vi) The Baltimore County Branch of the National Association for the

25 MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES LOCAL 3, COUNCIL 434; AND

26 (XII) THE CITIZENS ADVISORY COUNCIL FOR GIFTED AND  
27 TALENTED EDUCATION

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the term of the initial member  
2 of the Greater Baltimore County Chamber of Commerce under § 8-2B-03 of the Education  
3 Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, shall serve the remainder of the term of the  
4 member of the Baltimore County Chamber of Commerce, subject to Section 3 of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

6 (a) The terms of the following members of the Baltimore County School Board  
7 Nominating Commission shall terminate at the end of September 30, 2028:

8 (1) each member appointed by:

9 (i) the Baltimore County Branch of the National Association for the  
10 Advancement of Colored People;

11 (ii) the Education Support Personnel of Baltimore County;

12 (iii) the Teachers Association of Baltimore County;

13 (iv) Towson University;

14 (v) the League of Women Voters of Baltimore County; and

15 (vi) the Baltimore County Student Councils; and

16 (2) the members appointed by the Governor representing:

17 (i) district 6;

18 (ii) district 8;

19 (iii) district 11; and

20 (iv) district 43.

21 (b) The terms of the following members of the Baltimore County School Board  
22 Nominating Commission shall terminate at the end of September 30, 2030:

23 (1) each member appointed by:

24 (i) the American Federation of State, County and Municipal  
25 Employees Local 3, Council 434;

26 (ii) the Citizens Advisory Council for Gifted and Talented Education;

27 (iii) the Greater Baltimore County Chamber of Commerce;

1 (iv) the PTA Council of Baltimore County, Inc.;

2 (v) the Baltimore County Public Schools' Special Education Citizens'  
3 Advisory Committee; and

4 (vi) the Council of Administrative and Supervisory Employees;

5 (2) the at-large member appointed by the County Executive of Baltimore  
6 County; and

7 (3) the members appointed by the Governor representing:

8 (i) district 7;

9 (ii) district 10;

10 (iii) district 42; and

11 (iv) district 44.

12 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
13 October 1, 2026.
