A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws – Bicycles, Play Vehicles, and Unicycles – Crosswalks**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a person operating a bicycle, play vehicle, or unicycle at an
4 intersection who is facing a red signal to enter the intersection to cross the highway
5 in the direction of a pedestrian control “walk” signal; and generally relating to the
6 operation of bicycles, play vehicles, and unicycles at crosswalks.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Transportation**

15 21–1202.

16 (a) Every person operating a bicycle or a motor scooter in a public bicycle area
17 has all the rights granted to and is subject to all the duties required of the driver of a vehicle
18 by this title, including the duties set forth in § 21–504 of this title, except:

19 (1) As otherwise provided in this subtitle; and

20 (2) For those provisions of this title that by their very nature cannot apply.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



(b) (1) Subject to paragraphs (2), (3), and (4) of this subsection, a person has the rights and is subject to the restrictions applicable to pedestrians under this title while the person is lawfully operating a bicycle, play vehicle, or unicycle:

(i) On a sidewalk or sidewalk area; or

(ii) In or through a crosswalk.

(2) (I) [At] **EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, AT** an intersection, a person operating a bicycle, play vehicle, or unicycle is subject to all traffic control signals, as provided in §§ 21–202 and 21–203 of this title.

(II) 1. **UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY A TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE, A PERSON OPERATING A BICYCLE, PLAY VEHICLE, OR UNICYCLE AT AN INTERSECTION WHO IS FACING A RED SIGNAL MAY ENTER THE INTERSECTION TO CROSS THE HIGHWAY IN THE DIRECTION OF A PEDESTRIAN CONTROL “WALK” SIGNAL DISPLAYED FOR THE PORTION OF THE HIGHWAY ON WHICH THE BICYCLE, PLAY VEHICLE, OR UNICYCLE IS TRAVELING.**

2. **BEFORE ENTERING AN INTERSECTION AS DESCRIBED IN SUBSUBPARAGRAPH 1 OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH, A PERSON OPERATING A BICYCLE, PLAY VEHICLE, OR UNICYCLE SHALL YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO ANY VEHICLE OR PEDESTRIAN LAWFULLY USING THE INTERSECTION.**

(3) A person operating a bicycle, play vehicle, or unicycle on a sidewalk or sidewalk area or in or through a crosswalk shall yield the right-of-way to a pedestrian or a person riding on an electric personal assistive mobility device.

(4) Section 21–506 of this title does not apply to a person operating a bicycle, play vehicle, or unicycle.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2026.
