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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Washington County – Sales and Use Tax Exemption – Target Redevelopment**  
3 **Area**

4 FOR the purpose of providing an exemption from the sales and use tax for certain  
5 construction material or warehousing equipment used on certain property in  
6 Washington County; and generally relating to sales and use tax exemptions.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Tax – General**

15 **11-247.**

16 **(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS**  
17 **INDICATED.**

18 **(2) (I) “CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL” MEANS AN ITEM OF TANGIBLE**  
19 **PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT IS USED TO CONSTRUCT OR RENOVATE A BUILDING, A**  
20 **STRUCTURE, OR AN IMPROVEMENT ON LAND AND THAT TYPICALLY LOSES ITS**  
21 **SEPARATE IDENTITY AS PERSONAL PROPERTY ONCE INCORPORATED INTO THE**  
22 **REAL PROPERTY.**

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EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



6 (I) IS COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE MOUNT AETNA TECHNOLOGY  
7 PARK AND ACCESSIBLE FROM ROBINWOOD DRIVE, MOUNT AETNA ROAD, AND  
8 YALE DRIVE; AND

9 (II) IS LOCATED IN AN OFFICE, RESEARCH, AND INDUSTRY  
10 ZONING DISTRICT.

14 (B) THE SALES AND USE TAX DOES NOT APPLY TO A SALE OF CONSTRUCTION  
15 MATERIAL OR WAREHOUSING EQUIPMENT IF:

16 (1) THE MATERIAL OR EQUIPMENT IS PURCHASED BY A PERSON  
17 SOLELY FOR USE IN A TARGET REDEVELOPMENT AREA; AND

18 (2) THE BUYER PROVIDES THE VENDOR WITH EVIDENCE OF  
19 ELIGIBILITY FOR THE EXEMPTION ISSUED BY THE COMPTROLLER.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
21 1, 2026. It shall remain effective for a period of 10 years and, at the end of June 30, 2036,  
22 this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and  
23 of no further force and effect.
